  - Need to be family focused. Families need to take the lead for their children
  - Want to flip the order of the strategies starting with families
- Messaging
  - Want to have consistent message for all target populations families, providers, legislators, etc.
  - One campaign/one message
  - Message needs to include "infant mental health"
- · Funding available
  - Project Launch message campaign
  - Action plan should address protective factors
- · Age range should include prenatal to age 3
- · Need to address relationships, attachment/trauma
- · Promote the ASQ-3 and the ASQ:S/E
- Need to look at the ECCS Objectives action plan (Sent after the meeting)
- · Trainings

  - Offer online trainings
  - Utilize EPIC @ CHDI
  - Develop a common training for all home visitors
