The following reflects their initial thoughts         <ul> <li>Lauren reported that DMHAS is in discussion around policy priorities for upcoming legislative session and is pending a decision from their leadership.</li> <li>Group would like to know what the status is on the Statewide Opioid Response Directive (SWORD)</li> <li>Ban on Flavor Vaping was raised</li> <li>Mandate proposed to co-locate naloxone where any AEDs are made available.
