		indicated on the initial pump request, to be a	
		reoccurring order, but if not, they can be ordered anytime. Of note, Cigna provides additional flanges,	
		bottles, and tubing without a prescription.	
		Currently duck bills and back flow protectors do not	
		have a billing code, therefore are not covered. But are not expensive.

		The preferred way to get a pump order for HUSKY	
		participants in online because it confirms the address	
		which is required by HUSKY. www.ordermypump.com	
		Otherwise, if from OB office, it requires the DME	
		provider to call each participant to confirm address.	
		It also helps if participants call their provider, tell them	
		they ordered a pump from Acelleron and ask them	
		to send an Rx in to 1-866-615-6082. Or if they can, let	
		their provider know they ordered a pump and	
		Acelleron will be sending over an Rx request.	

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	Jan also provided an overview of the pumps	
	covered for HUSKY/Medicaid that they carry.	
	The What to Expect Form was translated into several languages- English, Spanish, Arabic, Pashtu, Turkish,	
	Polish, Russian, Portuguese, French, Chinese, and	
	Albanian.	
	A pump that may be good for individuals with previous breast surgery is the Cimilre P5+ which is a	
	dual motor and covered by Medicaid.	
	As of April 1st, Husky B members are fully covered for a	
	breast pump and breast milk storage bags after they deliver!
