WIC Staff Guidance for Issuance of Breast Pumps

When to refer to a DBE/Breastfeeding Coordinator:

- Whenever nutritionist or staff issuing a pump has a question regarding the policy of issuing breast pumps, or is uncertain about which kind of pump would be appropriate at the time of issuance
 - *Ideally, the training and guidance provided in this Content Sheet, annual reviews by the agency's DBE/
 Breastfeeding Coordinator, USDA/FNS Breastfeeding Core Curriculum provides staff with the confidence to issue pumps using their judgment, but, staff can consult the DBE/Breastfeeding Coordinator.

When to refer to a lactation counselor (CLC):

For nutritionists who are not CLCs, refer to a CLC (either another WIC nutritionist or an outside resource) when
there are specific breastfeeding questions or concerns from a participant that the nutritionist is not YET able to
answer. Upon demonstrating competency in Level 3 of the USDA/FNS Breastfeeding Core Curriculum, all WIC
Nutritionists (CPA) are expected to provide a consistent level of breastfeeding assessment, education and
support.

When to refer to a lactation consultant (IBCLC):

- For non-IBCLCs, when there are questions about complex breastfeeding issues (mastitis, anatomical concerns with feeding) that cannot be addressed in the office or that need medical attention.

Peer Counselors:

- If your agency has a Peer Counselor Program or works with peer counselors they can be a good resource for questions regarding pump acquisition, distribution and support for a pumping plan for return to work, school or non-medical purposes. If a peer counselor is not contacted or available at time of pump issuance, documenting breast pump issuance or review of breast pump education in CT-WIC Breastfeeding Support and Notes Screen is required to ensure continuity of care.
