SUBJECT: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Availability and One Time Ordering

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) would like to provide its licensed healthcare entities with an opportunity for a **one-time order** for additional personal protective equipment. If you are interested in receiving PPE, please place an order in the DPH Submissions Portal under the "PPE Resource Request Form (<u>DPH-Submissions-Home Page (ct.gov)</u> by <u>Sunday, February 13, 2022</u>. When entering your request into the DPH Submissions Portal, please note that requests you make are for "cases" of the PPE, rather than individual boxes.

After a review of the requests, the DPH will work with partner agencies to provide the PPE through a point of distribution (POD) site at Camp Hartell in Windsor Locks, CT. We simply ask that you ensure you communicate within your own corporation so that requests for PPE are not duplicated.



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If corporate entities choose to enter one order for all facilities, please enter "[Request Title]-**Centralized Order**" in the Requester Title Field on the DPH Submissions form. This will ensure that we understand it is one order for multiple facilities.

The CT DPH will make every attempt to provide the entire amount of PPE requested, so please request only what you can reasonably transport, store, and use.

A communication will be sent out on February 18, 2022 on points of distribution (POD) dates and locations meant only for those specific entities that placed orders for the PPE.
