ESTIMATED POPULATIONS IN CONNECTICUT AS OF JULY 1, 1998

Population estimates for 1998 for Connecticut's eight counties and 169 towns were prepared for distribution by the Connecticut Department of Public Health, Office of Policy, Planning, and Evaluation. The 1998 estimates are consistent with the new estimation method adopted in 1998.⁽¹⁾ These estimates constitute the basis of birth, death, and other population-based rates for 1997 and forward.

Method of Estimation

County and Town Estimates

In odd-numbered years, the U.S. Census Bureau's Population Estimates Program issues total population estimates for Connecticut counties and towns as of July 1 of the prior year. The 1998 estimates were released June 30, 1999. Consequently, for even-numbered years such as 1998, the U.S. Census Bureau figures are adopted *without modification* for the state's town-level estimates.

1998 Population Estimates

The 1998 population estimate for the state of Connecticut compared to the 1990 U.S. Census population count is shown below. Population estimates for Connecticut's counties and towns are given in the attached table.
