ESTIMATED POPULATIONS IN CONNECTICUT AS OF JULY 1, 2009

Population estimates of Connecticut's eight counties and 169 towns for 2009 were prepared for distribution by the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), Health Care Quality, Statistics, Analysis, and Reporting Unit, within the Division of Health Information Systems Reporting. These estimates constitute the basis of birth, death, and other population-based rates for 2009 and forward.

Method of Estimation

County and Town Estimates

Town population estimates for July 1, 2009 were released by the U.S. Census Bureau's (USCB) Population Estimates Program on September 9, 2010.⁽¹⁾ These USCB figures were adopted for the state's town-level estimates. The method used by the USCB to calculate population estimates at the subcounty level is described in detail at <u>http://www.census.gov/popest/topics/methodology/2009_su_meth.pdf</u>

2009 Population Estimates

The July 1, 2009 population estimate for the state of Connecticut is 3,518,288 ⁽²⁾. The 2009 estimate was 108,739 higher than the July 1, 2000 population estimate of 3,409,549 ⁽³⁾. Population estimates for Connecticut's counties and towns are given in the attached table.
