ESTIMATED POPULATIONS IN CONNECTICUT AS OF JULY 1, 2010

Population estimates of Connecticut’s eight counties and 169 towns for 2010 were prepared for distribution by the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), Health Care Quality, Statistics, Analysis, and Reporting Unit, within the Division of Health Information Systems Reporting. These estimates constitute the basis of birth, death, and other population-based rates for 2010 and forward.

Method of Estimation

County and Town Estimates

The April 1, 2010 Census count was used as the base population figure for each town ⁽¹⁾. The change in population for the three months between April 1, 2010 and July 1, 2010 was estimated by calculating the “natural increase” in population (i.e. births minus deaths) and the estimated net migration during this period. Three-month birth and death counts were based on tabulations of provisional 2010 birth and death files. Net migration was estimated for each town based on the population change and the natural increase in population over the last decade (2000-2010). The estimated three-month population change was added to the base April 1, 2010 population figure for each town to calculate the July 1, 2010 population estimate.

2010 Population Estimates

The July 1, 2010 population estimate for the state of Connecticut is 3,577,845. The 2010 estimate was 168,259 higher than the revised July 1, 2000 population estimate of 3,409,586 ⁽²⁾. Population estimates for Connecticut's counties and towns are given in the attached table.
