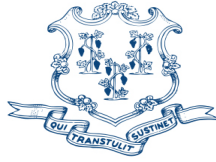

RE: Ventilator Retrieval

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) is retrieving Pulmonentic LTV 1200, Impact Eagle Vents (Model 754 Univent), and V+Pro High Flow Nasal Cannula (HFNC) ventilators that were deployed to Connecticut hospitals several years ago and during the COVID-19 surge. These ventilators have either reached their end of life, are underutilized, or scheduled for return to the Strategic National Stockpile.

A representative from the DPH Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response (OPHPR) will contact you directly within the next few days to provide you with a list of these ventilators located at your hospitals. We ask that you return these ventilators to our warehouse during the week of August 8, 2022. The warehouse is located at:

Please inform OPHPR if you continue to have a need for ventilators beyond your current inventory. We will work with you to make ventilators available if there remains a need. Further correspondence will follow concerning the availability of new ventilators.
