RE:	Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC1) Enhancing Detection Budget Period 2 (BP2) - Budget Revision Request Deadline	

Health Departments and Districts with an approved budget for the ELC1 BP2 (May 18, 2021 – November 17, 2022) funding have until <u>September 29, 2022</u>, to submit a budget revision request (BRR). BRRs received after the September 29, 2022, deadline will not be accepted.

BRRs are required if any projected changes in funding utilization result in expenditures that exceed an approved budget line item by more than 20%, or if a new line item or activity is being added. Departmental approval is required, prior to any changes being implemented.

The following process shall be utilized by all health departments/districts when requesting a BRR:

- 1. The health department/district shall submit the proposed changes and written justifications to: <u>LHD-ELCinbox@ct.gov</u>
- 2. The following documents are required when submitting a BRR:
 - a. A completed and signed BRR form outlining funding changes
 - b. A revised Budget Justification for the proposed changes
 - c. A revised Salary/Fringe Position Schedule for any adjustments to salary and fringe
 - d. A revised Subcontractor Detail Form for any new and/or revised subcontractor information
 - e. A revised and signed ELC Enhancing Detection Funding Application Budget Page

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- 3. Upon approval, a copy of the DPH-approved BRR documentation will be returned to you electronically.
- 4. Health departments/districts are responsible for ensuring that all final expenditure reports reflect the latest budget revision request on file with the State Department of Public Health.
