Last Spring, DPH asked regional Emergency Support Function 8 (ESF8) and HCC members to complete an online survey to identify and rank hazards in Connecticut. The results of that survey were used to develop the 2022 HVA/JRA. To access the HVA/JRA, please visit this [link](#).

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response, requires Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) program and Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) cooperative agreement recipients to complete a HVA/JRA to inform planning priorities for public health, and healthcare emergency preparedness and response. The results of the HVA/JRA are referenced by DPH and HHS to prioritize preparedness and response-related activities.
