RE: Ventilators

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Connecticut purchased 100 [Bio-Med TV-100 transport ventilators](#), which we currently store in our warehouse. DPH is offering Connecticut hospitals the opportunity to take possession of these ventilators for their use, storage and maintenance.

Several hospitals are in possession of LTV-1200 ventilators, which were purchased by DPH several years ago. DPH is also offering these ventilators to hospitals that wish to keep them in their possession and assume responsibility for their maintenance.

DPH will work with hospitals interested in either of these models to execute a formal, no-cost agreement which defines the terms of their use, storage, and maintenance.
