Located at Camp Hartell in Windsor Locks, CT, the NEDTC mission is to prepare local, state and federal entities to respond to natural and manmade disasters by facilitating regional, state and national planning, training and exercises in disaster response, and strengthening regional emergency coordination.

NEDTC also provides a base for the Ottilie W. Lundgren Memorial Mobile Field Hospital. The Mobile Field Hospital is a 100-bed mobile field hospital designed to support the state's health care system in response to a man-made or natural disaster that results in an overwhelming number of sick or injured people.
