On behalf of the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH), Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response, I'm pleased to present the Connecticut Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) Strategic Plan. The plan, developed by a planning team comprised of MRC leaders across Connecticut, resulted from a strategic planning process DPH began in January 2019.

The plan establishes the Connecticut MRC vision, mission, and core values, as well as five goals with corresponding objectives and strategies. The plan prioritizes these strategies and describes a path for implementation, which is organized into three phases. The strategic planning team will continue their work with the Connecticut MRC Coordinator to assure progress on the plan, timely implementation and continuous improvement efforts.

This plan, the first of its kind in Connecticut, provides a consistent framework that will guide the work of Connecticut's MRC units and lead to a robust network of volunteers that serves to strengthen Connecticut's public health preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities.
