INTRODUCTION

Rates shown are crude rates, or the number of cancers divided by the total population for each sex. Rates are per 100,000 males or females. Populations by sex and town (as of July 1, 1997) are estimates. Details on methods of population estimates are available from DPH. Crude rates are not adjusted for age differences in the populations of the towns.

Data for certain small towns are subject to errors due to problems in addresses of patients in the Connecticut Tumor Registry. Data for the towns of Canaan and North Canaan were combined, due to problems in coding in the Registry. For some patients the only address is a post-office box, and may not be the actual town of residence. The cancer rate may appear to be high for one town (with a post office) and may appear to be low for another town (without a post office). This occurs, for example, in the Voluntown-Griswold area.

Numbers of cancers shown are invasive cancers, and do not include non-invasive (or "in situ") cancer. The sole exception is for bladder cancer, where cancers coded as "in situ" are counted as invasive, because of well-known problems in accuracy of coding in cancer registries. This procedure is also followed in reports from the National Cancer Institute.

The total number of invasive cancers for many towns is very small. Numbers of cancers for each town may fluctuate considerably from year to year. The confidence limits (95%, lower and upper limits) provide an indication of statistical variability. Even for all invasive cancers combined, confidence limits on the crude rate are wide for many towns. Confidence limits are not shown for towns with no cancers or only one cancer.

Aside from statistical variability and fluctuations in rates from year to year, apparent variation in crude incidence rates among the towns may reflect differences in the population distributions by age and socioeconomic status. For example, almost all of the variation in age-adjusted incidence rates for invasive breast cancer by town has been shown to disappear after adjustment for differences in socioeconomic indicators by town (using Census data). However, some variation in age-adjusted rates by town was found for melanoma of the skin, including higher rates in certain towns on the ocean shoreline. Copies of reports on these cancers (breast and melanoma) are available from the Connecticut Tumor Registry. A bibliography of all publications from the Registry is available on the internet website for the Department of Public Health (www.state.ct.us/dph) or from the Registry.

Rapid changes in screening rates for certain cancers (such as breast and prostate) can lead to rapid changes in number of cancers detected and reported. The high crude rate for cancer in Old Lyme in males in 1997 was largely due to an increase in prostate cancer, which could be related to screening.
