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Incidence of Selected Cancers in Connecticut
by Town, 1999

Introduction and Methods

The population-based Connecticut Tumor Registry (CTR) frequently receives inquiries concerning whether or not the number of cancers in a given town, or group of towns, is usual in comparison with other parts of the state. This monograph is intended to provide some data that should be useful in answering these questions.

This monograph presents data for incident cancers diagnosed among Connecticut residents during 1999. Other recent reports from the CTR have included data incident cancers diagnosed in 1997 and 1998. Incidence data for a single year of diagnosis must be used with caution, because numbers of cancers are small and fluctuate randomly from year to year. Surveillance of cancer incidence by town is an ongoing effort of the CTR. Future analyses will include data for diagnoses in the years 2000 and 2001. This will allow comparison with findings reported for cancers diagnosed in 1989-91 (Polednak and Flannery, 1995), so that any suggested trends in cancer incidence rates by town can be determined.

The current report uses data on the Connecticut population from the year 2000 Census were used for the age distribution of each town, for males and females separately. This report excludes "in situ" (non-invasive) cancers, with the sole exception of bladder tumors. Because of well-known problems in distinguishing in situ from invasive bladder tumors, the National Cancer Institute includes both in situ and invasive bladder cancers when reporting data on invasive cancers.

Data for all invasive cancers combined are most frequently requested, and are provided in this report. Included also are data for the most common

cancers, with more than 300 cancers statewide for 1999 in either males or females. This decision was based on the fact that there are 169 towns and numbers for certain types of cancer are small for many towns. However, several other cancers were also included because of special interest. For melanoma of the skin, which is also included, incidence rates have previously been shown to differ by town of residence in Connecticut. Leukemia is included because requests for data are frequently received by the Registry from the public and media. Invasive cervical cancer is of special interest because of the important role of screening in preventing these cancers.

Numbers presented in this report are cancers, not persons with cancer. An individual can be diagnosed with two different types of cancer at the same time or during a given time period.

Calculation and Presentation of Standardized Incidence Ratios (SIRs)

For each town, the observed number of cancers (for each sex, where appropriate) is compared with the number expected for each town if statewide incidence rates prevailed. The ratio of the observed to the expected number of cancers for each town is the "standardized incidence ratio" or SIR. Crude incidence rates for each sex for each town also can be calculated by dividing the number of cancers by the population of males or females in each town from the Year 2000 Census; these populations are listed in the Appendix.

In calculating SIRs, the statewide incidence rates for 1999 for each specific type of cancer for males and females by age group were first obtained, using state population estimates by age and sex (as of July 1st, 2000). These rates were multiplied by the male or female populations in each age group in the town from the 2000 Census; the sum of these products, across all the age groups, is the expected number of cancers, as shown in the tables in this report. Age was in five-year intervals from 0-4 to 80-84 years, along with age 85 years or older (as the last or oldest age interval).

An SIR of 1.00 (also sometimes expressed as 100%) indicates that the number of cancers observed for a town was equal to the number expected for the town's population on the basis of statewide cancer incidence rates).

The analysis of SIRs by geographic area is a tool in cancer surveillance. The use of SIRs, however, does not permit identification of specific age subgroups that may be involved in the finding of elevated or reduced SIRs in specific towns. This would require examination of age-specific incidence rates, which for many towns involve small numbers of cancers and (hence) large statistical uncertainty.

Interpretation of SIRs

Apparent geographic variation in SIRs must be interpreted with caution. Due to problems with assigning residence to the towns of North Canaan (which includes a Village named Canaan) and Canaan, data for these two towns were combined in all tables in this report. As with other cancer registries, the only address reported to the CTR for some persons is a post-office box rather than the actual residence. Thus, a town with a post office has an unusually high SIR while an adjacent town without a post office has an unusually low SIR. For example, a large proportion of records coded with Voluntown as the town of residence have a post office box as the only address in the CTR; some of these patients are residents of the adjacent town of Griswold, which has no post office. Several other small towns do not have a post office, so that data for all small towns. For example, some residents of Warren have mail delivery while others do not; the mailing address for some residents of Warren is Cornwall Bridge (Town of Cornwall). Therefore, cancer rates may appear unusually high or low, due to errors in assigning town of residence. This problem has also been reported for the New York state cancer registry (Nasca et al., 1980).

An elevated SIR does not necessarily indicate a finding of public health significance. Elevated SIRs can occur due to inaccuracies in

population estimates (by age and sex), as well as inaccuracies in assignment to town of residence, chance or random variation, and differences in the socioeconomic status of residents of different towns, rather than to any effects of living in a particular town. With regard to population estimates, the Bureau of the Census has indicated an error in assigning some residents to West Hartford vs. Hartford in the Year 2000 Census; corrected data have not been obtained.

Differences in cancer incidence rates by town may reflect the association between socioeconomic status and cancer rates (Baquet et al., 1991). For some types of cancer, such as cancers of the uterine cervix and lung, incidence rates tend to be higher in the lower levels of socioeconomic status (social class) as usually defined by level of education or income. For a few types of cancer, such as breast and testis, incidence rates are higher in higher socioeconomic status groups.

The association between higher socioeconomic status and risk of breast cancer is due at least in part to differences in fertility and reproductive history, which are major known risk factors for breast cancer. Rates for certain other cancers are not associated with socioeconomic status but with population density (that is, the number of people per square mile). Thus, differences in SIRs among towns may reflect differences in these characteristics of the residents, rather than differences in the general environment.

In the 1990 Census, median household income varied from around \$80,000-104,000 in several towns in the southwestern corner of the state (near New York City) to less than \$30,000 in New London, Norwich, Putnam and Windham, and less than \$25,000 in Bridgeport and Hartford. Other higher-income regions include several suburban towns in the Hartford and New Haven areas. The proportion of persons with incomes below the federal poverty threshold, which takes into account the number of persons in a household, was highest in

Hartford (27.5%) and New Haven (21.3%) and greater than 10% for several other towns (Bridgeport, Mansfield, New Britain, New London, Norwich, Putnam, Sprague, Waterbury and Windham).

Because the risk of breast cancer is increased among women of higher socioeconomic status, towns with larger proportions of such women will have relatively high SIRs prior to adjustment based on socioeconomic indicators for each town but not after adjustment (Polednak, 1998). In contrast, towns with higher levels of income will tend to have a lower prevalence of cigarette smokers, and (hence) lower rates for lung cancer and other cancers related to smoking.

The distribution of racial-ethnic groups also differs by county and town. The proportions of black and Hispanic persons in the population in the 1990 Census were highest in the largest cities (Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven and Waterbury). Total cancer incidence rates are higher for blacks (and especially black males) and lower for Hispanics, relative to rates for all groups combined or for non-Hispanic whites. Although these racial-ethnic differences are due largely to differences in socioeconomic status, explanations for some racial-ethnic differences for specific cancer sites may be more complex.

The present report did not attempt to provide separate SIRs for blacks or for Hispanics, because of the small population sizes and the small numbers of cancers in many towns. There are problems with identifying Hispanics in the registry. However, differences in racial-ethnic composition among the towns and counties should be considered in interpreting the SIRs.

Certain cancers, such as breast and prostate, are often detected by screening tests, including mammography and clinical breast examination for breast cancer, and both digital rectal examination and prostate-specific antigen (PSA) testing for prostate. Because rates of cancer screening may vary geographically, the distribution of detected cancers over space and time

may be affected. Also, a long time period or "latency" generally occurs between exposure to a cancer-causing agent ("carcinogen") and diagnosis of cancer related to that exposure; one example is the long time interval between initiation of tobacco use and diagnosis of lung cancer. The mobility of the population reduces the possibility that any exposures occurring during recent residence in a given town are related to the development of cancer; rather, exposures occurring many years earlier, during residence in another geographic area, may be important.

Cancers associated with general environmental exposures such as ambient air and water pollution may be expected to be elevated for both males and females in geographic areas with higher levels of these agents. For other risk factors, such as diet and smoking habits, gender differences in the prevalence of the risk factor may exist within a given region but adequate data on the prevalence of cancer risk factors within Connecticut are not available, so that interpretation of SIRs is difficult. Analyses of geographic patterns in SIRs could suggest the need to consider special surveys of risk factors in specific regions.

High SIRs for lung cancer in certain geographic areas could suggest the need for intensified smoking prevention and cessation programs. High SIRs for skin melanomas in specific towns could indicate the need for public education regarding the dangers of excessive sun exposure.

Highlights of the Data

All Invasive Cancers Combined

In males, a few towns had slightly elevated SIRs, which could be explained by problems with post-office box addresses. SIRs for the largest towns (Bridgeport, Hartford and New Haven), with large proportions of lower-income persons and blacks, were greater than 1.00. In females, high SIRs were evident for several affluent towns (Weston, Westport, Wilton and Woodbridge),

for which the predicted SIR was also elevated. This pattern is largely due to elevated incidence rates for breast cancer.

Lung Cancer

For males, towns with elevated SIRs included several with less-affluent populations. Elevated SIRs were not generally found for females in these towns, but the numbers of cancers involved were smaller than for males and many SIRs were statistically unreliable. SIRs were elevated for females in certain towns in New London county, as also reported previously (Polednak and Flannery, 1995). Elevated SIRs could be due to chance, or could reflect lower income, prevalence of smokers, and/or occupational factors; occupational exposures account for a small proportion of all lung cancers.

Breast Cancer

SIRs were elevated for several towns (e.g., Glastonbury, Ridgefield, Simsbury, and the Westport area) with relatively high socioeconomic indicators in the U.S. census (Polednak, 1998).

Geographic differences in breast cancer screening rates can affect the distribution of reported cancers by space and time; that is, more intense screening programs or efforts in specific geographic areas may lead to (at least temporary) increases in the number of breast cancers detected.

Prostate Cancer

Several towns in the Hartford area had SIRs that were higher than predicted; this finding has been noted in previous reports from the Registry. The high SIR for Bloomfield may be due (at least in part) to the large proportion of blacks in the population.

Geographic variation must be interpreted with caution because the incidence of detected cancers is influenced by medical care, which affects the probability of detecting "latent" or clinically silent cancers. Detection of more cancers through increased screening of asymptomatic

patients may lead to temporary increases in incidence rates (mainly for early-stage cancers).

Melanoma of Skin

Relatively high SIRs were found for certain towns on the ocean shoreline (including Guilford and Wesport in males, and Greenwich in females) and several other towns in areas with lakes. It appears that certain towns with relatively high socioeconomic status, low proportions of blacks and location on the ocean shoreline have relatively high SIRs. Several publications from the Registry have dealt with this issue (see References, listed below).

Colon and Rectal Cancer

As in previous reports from the CTR, there was limited geographic variation in incidence rates for colon and rectal cancer at the town level. The causes of colorectal cancer are poorly understood, although inherited genetic factors are involved in a small proportion of cases and dietary factors (such as low intake of certain fruits and vegetables) are probably also involved.

Noteworthy are higher SIRS for colon (but not rectal) cancer in males and females in Waterbury, along with Derby and Shelton; this was not noted in previous Registry monographs, and could be due to chance, but continued surveillance is needed.

Cervical Cancer

Although numbers were small for most towns, noteworthy were the high SIRs for Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven and Stratford. These towns include high-poverty areas, where risk factors for cervical cancer tend to be more prevalent and cancer screening less prevalent (Polednak et al., 1991).

Other Cancers

Data for other cancers involve small numbers in most towns, and SIRs may appear elevated due to chance. Few towns had statistically significantly

elevated SIRs for bladder cancer; the higher SIRs for males but not females in Bristol and Morris could be due to chance, or possibly occupational exposures and/or smoking habits (see lung cancer). For leukemia elevated SIRs were found for a few towns, including Glastonbury males but not females, and East Granby females but not males. These findings were based on four or fewer cancers, and may be due to chance; continued surveillance is needed. For uterine corpus none of the towns with more than a few cancers had elevated SIRs; the problem with addresses in Voluntown has been noted. For ovary few towns had elevated SIRs, and these findings were not consistent with those reported for cancers diagnosed in 1989-91 (Polednak and Flannery, 1995); continued surveillance is needed, with additional years of data. Few towns had significantly elevated SIRs for non-Hodgkin's lymphoma and these were not consistent for males and females.

Conclusion

Variation in standardized incidence ratios (SIRs) among the towns should be interpreted with caution. High or low SIRs may not reflect any effect of living in a particular town, especially in view of population mobility and the long latent periods involved for many cancers. In addition to random (statistical) variation, SIRs are subject to the effects of inaccuracies in assignment of place of residence and may be affected by variation in cancer screening rates.

Variation in the characteristic of the population, including the distribution of socioeconomic status and racial-ethnic groups, must be considered in interpreting the SIRs by county and town. For melanoma of the skin, certain more-affluent ocean shoreline towns have high SIRs.

Even if the apparent variation in SIRs is largely "explained" by differences in socioeconomic status indicators among the towns, this information can be of practical importance.

Towns with low socioeconomic indicators tend to have relatively high prevalence rates of cigarette smoking; these towns could be specially targeted for interventions aimed at prevention or cessation of smoking. More-affluent towns could be specially targeted in programs aimed at primary prevention of breast cancer, through modification of lifestyle factors. More-affluent towns, especially certain towns on the ocean shoreline, could benefit from programs aimed at reducing excess recreational exposure to the sun (at beaches).

APPENDIX

Codes Used for Cancer Sites

The types of cancer presented in this report were defined by codes in the database of the Connecticut Tumor Registry, which uses the International Classification of Diseases for Oncology (ICD-O) codes for topography (site), morphology (histology) and behavior (i.e., benign, uncertain, in situ, and malignant). Certain benign tumors are reported to the registry but were not included in this report; as noted earlier, in situ tumors were also excluded from this report, with the sole exception of in situ bladder tumors (which were included). Lymphomas are not coded to the site of occurrence, but are grouped together into separate categories (i.e., Hodgkin's disease and non-Hodgkin's lymphoma), which were not included in this report.
