	<ul> <li>Setting an age at which the childcare contribution portion of a support order terminates, unless ordered otherwise by the court</li> <li>Giving credit for the voluntary support of a dependent child who is not residing with an obligor (ie, treating such a child as a "qualified child") when calculating the presumptive support amount</li> </ul>
