Lien Release Request

Under Public Act 21-3, any existing real property lien filed pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 17b-79 and 17b-93 to secure the State of Connecticut's right to recover the cost of certain public assistance shall be deemed released on July 1, 2021, unless the recovery of such assistance is required by federal law. While these liens are deemed released as a matter of law under Public Act 21-3, a landowner may request a formal release of the lien from the Department of Social Services (DSS) by completing this form and returning it to DSS by U.S. mail:
