The contract between City of Meriden ("Contractor") and the Connecticut Department of Social Services ("Department"), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Office of the Attorney General on 2/11/2016, and previously amended on 10/5/2016 is hereby further amended as follows:

- 1. The term of the contract is extended for an additional one (1) year and the end date of the contract is changed from 6/30/2017 to 6/30/2018.
- The total maximum amount payable under the contract has increased by \$76,514 from \$152,892 to \$229,406 to provide funding for the extended term of the contract.
