



# CT METS Planned Solutions

## System Integration Platform (SIP)

The SIP supports a central integration point for all MES solutions and enables and standardizes data sharing with external entities (e.g., state agencies, HIE, vendors, ASOs). The SIP applies industry standard security and privacy controls and ensures data meets MES data governance and quality standards.



## ECCM Iteration 1

### Enterprise Care and Case Management (ECCM)

Iteration 1 of DSS' **ECCM** solution is a new build to address an immediate need to replace a legacy system, *My Community Choices* (MCC) utilizing an approach that will form the foundation for a multi-agency ECCM solution.



## EDW&A

### Enterprise Data Warehouse and Analytics (EDW&A)

This will be a scalable **EDW&A** solution inclusive of trusted and securely accessible data that will enable an equity- and person-centered approach to facilitate transparency, robust reporting and sound decision-making for policy and programs that benefit all stakeholders.



## CFP

### Claims and Financial Processing (CFP)

The CFP solution is the core of the CT MES (Medicaid Enterprise System), supporting provider payments including claims processing and application of future payment models (e.g., value-based payments), in accordance with DSS policies. This effort will modernize these core services by either replacing or retooling the existing MMIS. The resulting solution enables DSS policy and operations to be rules-based and more responsive to evolving program changes. As DSS and its sister agencies look to better connect policy to recipient programs, this flexibility will be essential.



## EPM

### Enterprise Provider Management (EPM)

A Provider Management solution streamlines business operations to enroll and validate providers and manage provider networks. The result is an improved provider enrollment and renewal process, using smart rules, that enforce data quality while also reducing the administrative burden for providers and DSS staff who oversee the process.
