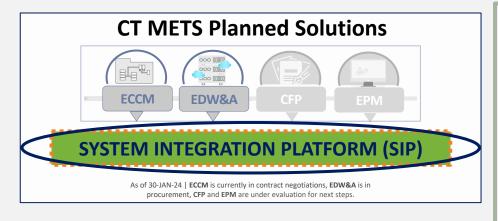


System Integration Platform (SIP)



What is a SIP?

The System Integration Platform (SIP) enables efficient integration of multiple Medicaid modules by providing a common data sharing platform across different Medicaid modules and external entities (state agencies, ASOs, etc.).

The SIP acts as an entry point for both internal and external systems that need to interact with Medicaid modules and enhances security aspects.

What are the major benefits of a SIP?

- Streamlines all forms of data communications across a centralized layer/platform
- > Reduces duplication of data across multiple modules
- > Provides centralized data transformation and standardization services
- > Ensures data standards for quality and uniformity
- > Supports Single Sign-on (SSO) to multiple Medicaid modules
- Enables flexible architecture, allowing modules to be upgraded/replaced with reduced effort
- > Enterprise (system-wide) services can be exposed to other systems/agencies such as address validation
- > Reduces or eliminates maintenance of custom, point-to-point interfaces
- > Supports enterprise-wide data governance
- > Supports centralized health check and monitoring of all Medicaid modules
