B. QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

1. **Question:** Can the TOP program be facilitated in an after-school setting? If an after-school setting is allowed is a letter of commitment from a host school still required (as outlined in Section 6, c of the RFP)?

Response: Afterschool models, while allowed, are not preferred, but must meet the same requirements as if it were administered during the school day. In addition, respondents that elect to utilize an afterschool approach must also describe the plan for transporting children home at the end of programming and to the program, if applicable.

A letter of commitment is required from a host school if the program is held during the day or after school. Further, if the program is held off site, a commitment letter from all schools from whom the students are recruited is required in order to achieve the necessary coordinated program infrastructure.
