Report of Findings

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Project Overview

- The State of Connecticut Department of Social Services (The Department) commissioned GreatBlue Research to conduct the 2021 PCMH+ Person-Centered Primary Care Measure (PCPCM) Survey with Provider Services utilizing telephonic and digital survey methodologies from September 9, 2021 to December 6, 2021. The sample universe consisted of adults and children enrolled in the HUSKY Health Program who were contacted in efforts to complete 5,838 surveys.
- The 2021 PCMH+ PCPCM Member Survey with Provider Services included the following areas of investigation:
 - PCMH+ Member satisfaction with Primary Care experience
 - Health care over the last 12 months
 - Member demographic information
- The primary goals of the research were to build an understanding of member opinions and perceptions as they pertain to care received from their Primary Care Provider, and enable Community Health Network of CT, Inc. (“CHNCT”) to identify near-term opportunities for improvement of Member Satisfaction with Provider Services.
- GreatBlue Research utilized the Person-Centered Primary Care Measure, or PCPCM, developed by the Larry A. Green Center, in order to achieve these goals. The PCPCM is a survey of primary care quality that focuses on the patient’s access to care, relationship with the physician, and ability to reach health outcome goals.
- Upon receipt of the survey instrument and a random sample list of members, GreatBlue call center and senior staff completed all remaining facets of the 2021 PCMH+ PCPCM Member Satisfaction Survey with Provider Services. These tasks included the following: survey programming, researcher training, survey pre-testing, full-scale fielding (telephone calls and digital collection), coding, data entry, editing, validation, verification, computer analysis, analysis and report writing.

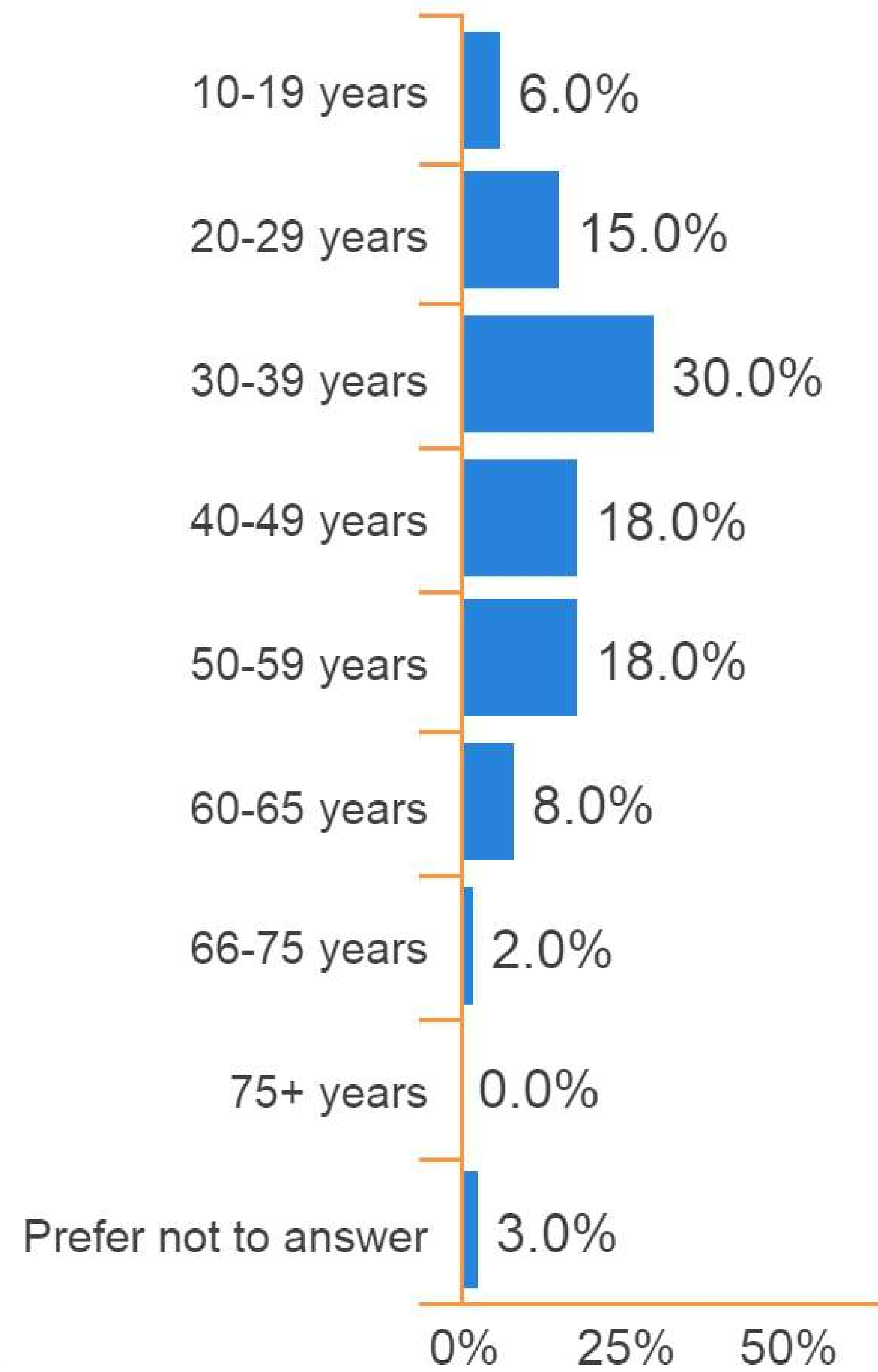

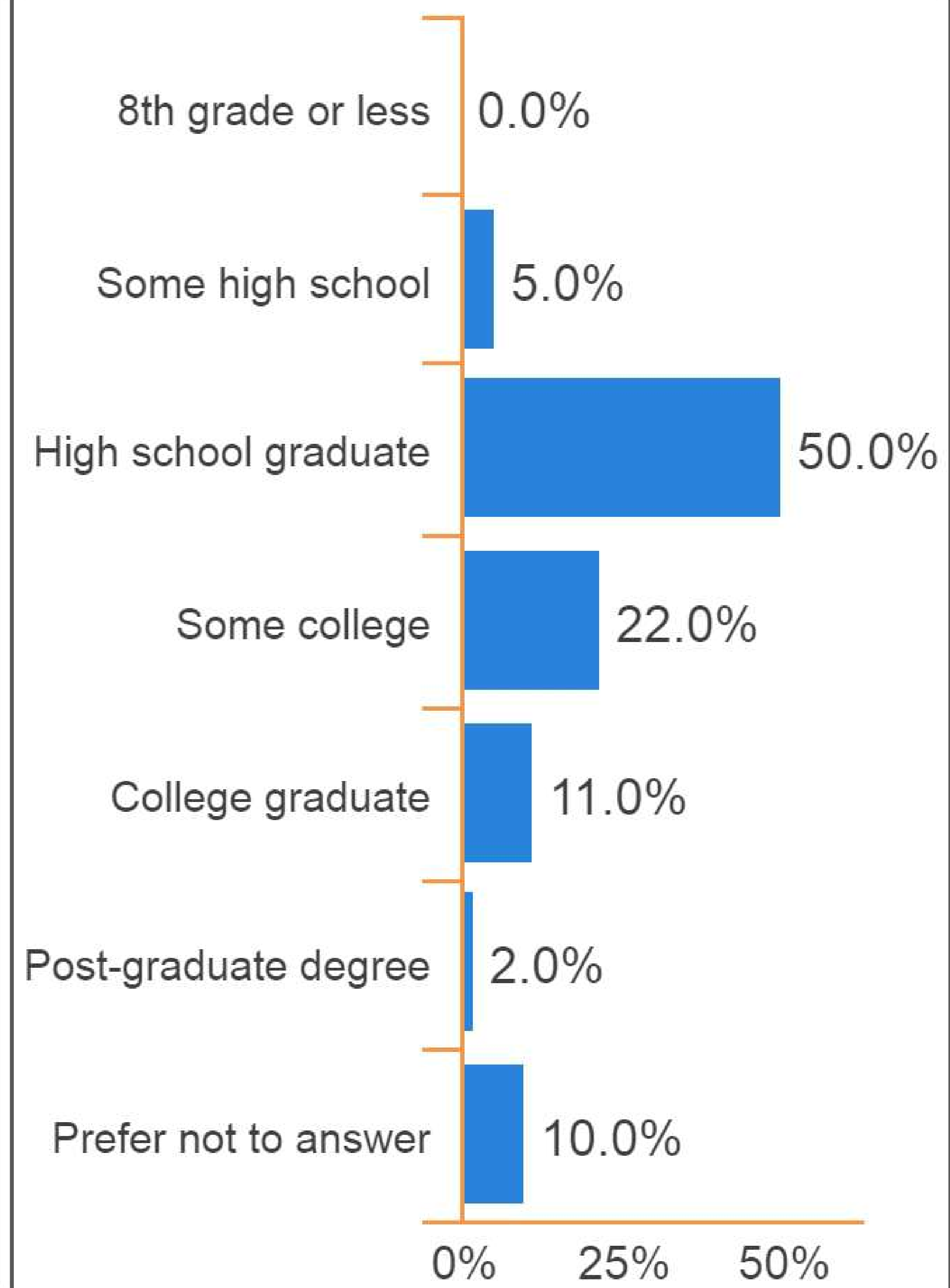

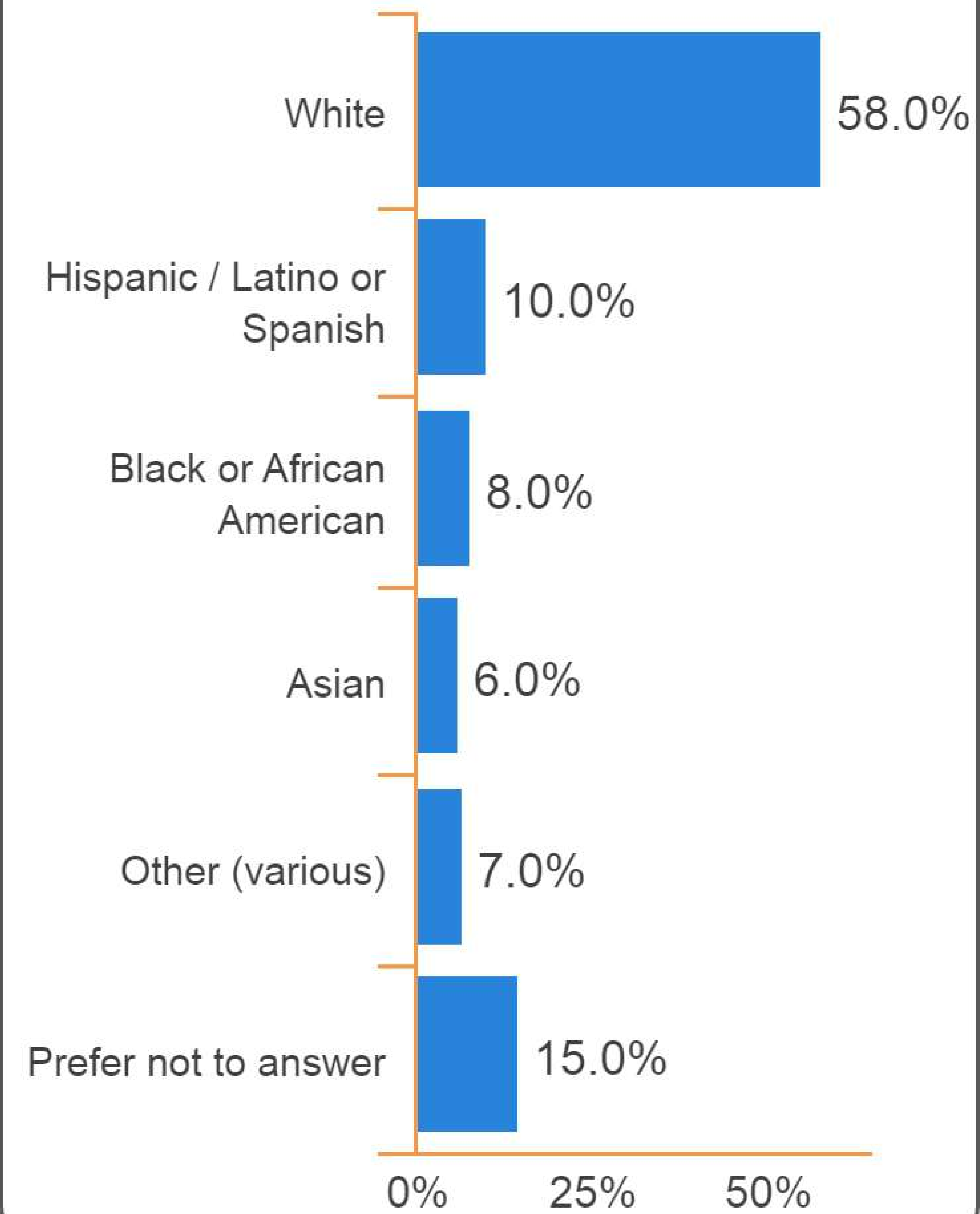

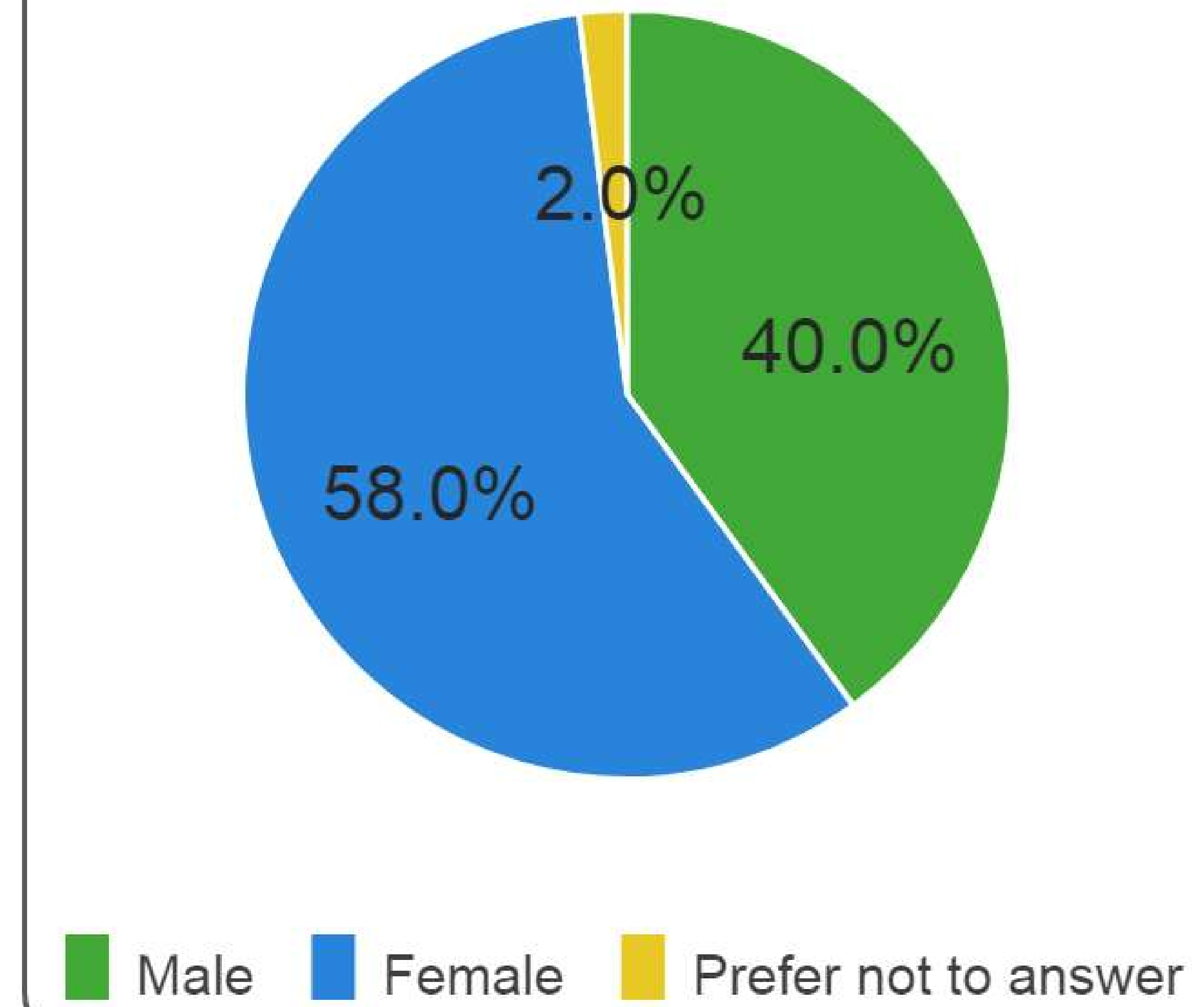

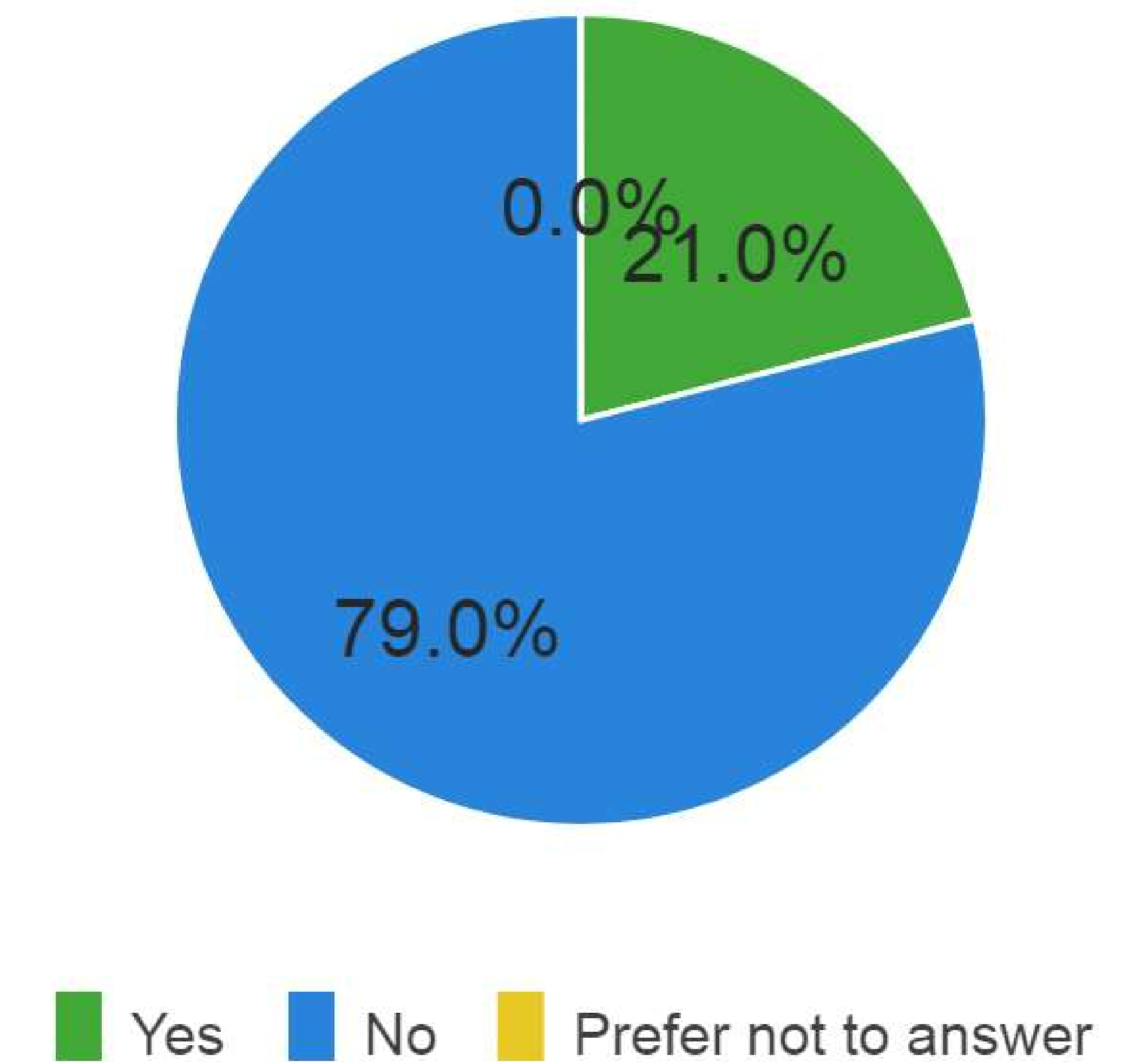

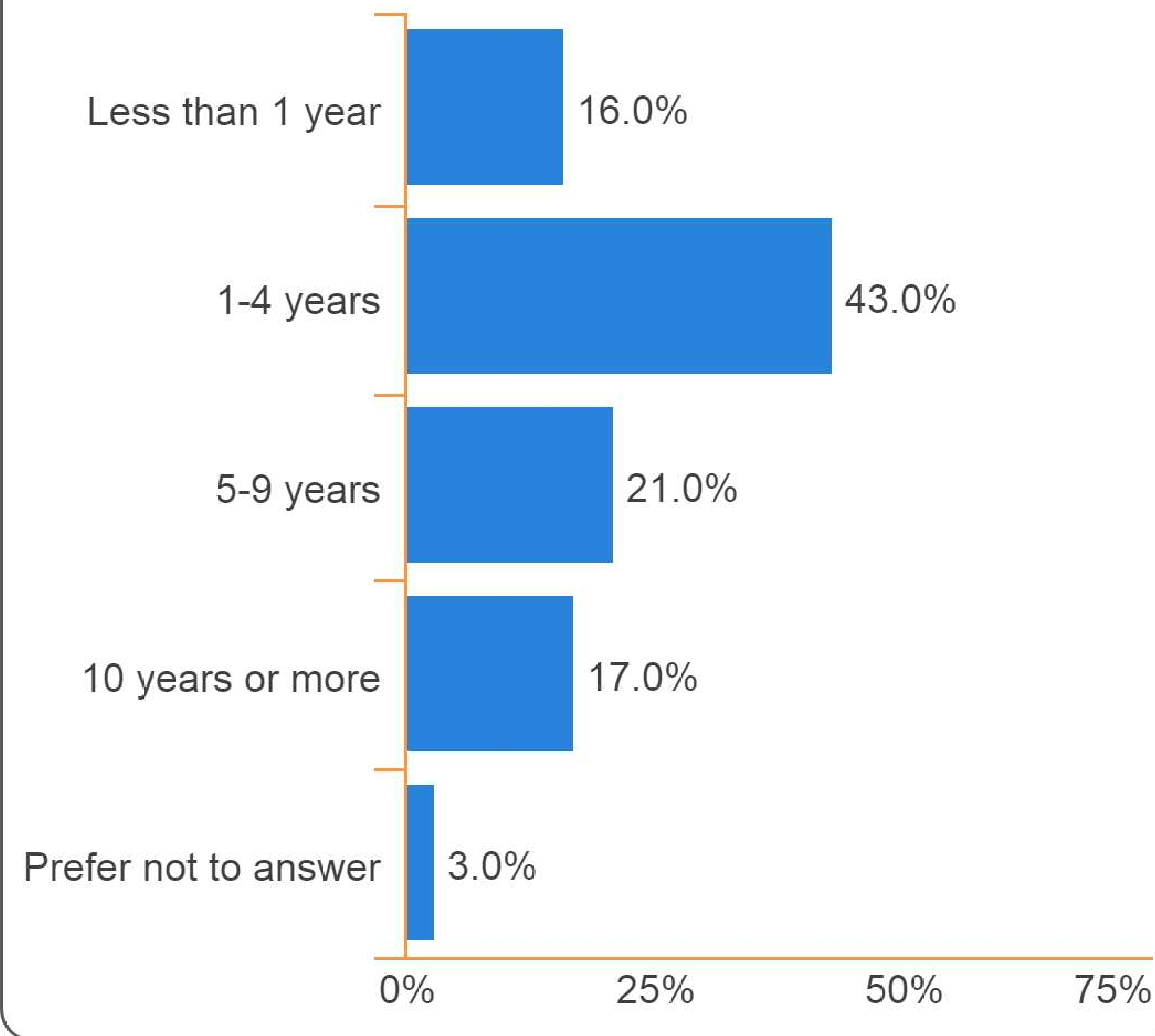

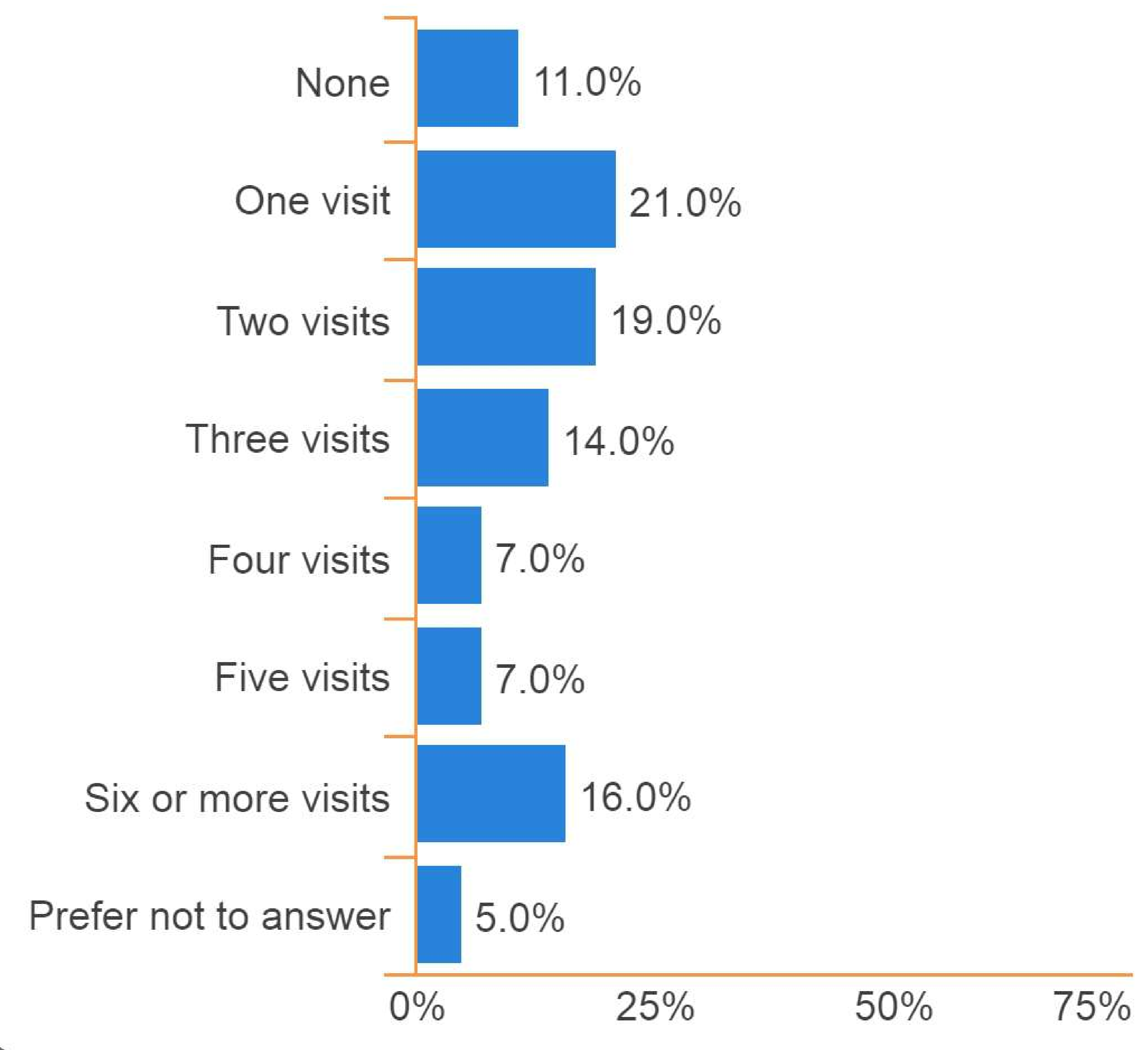


Respondent Demographics - Adult

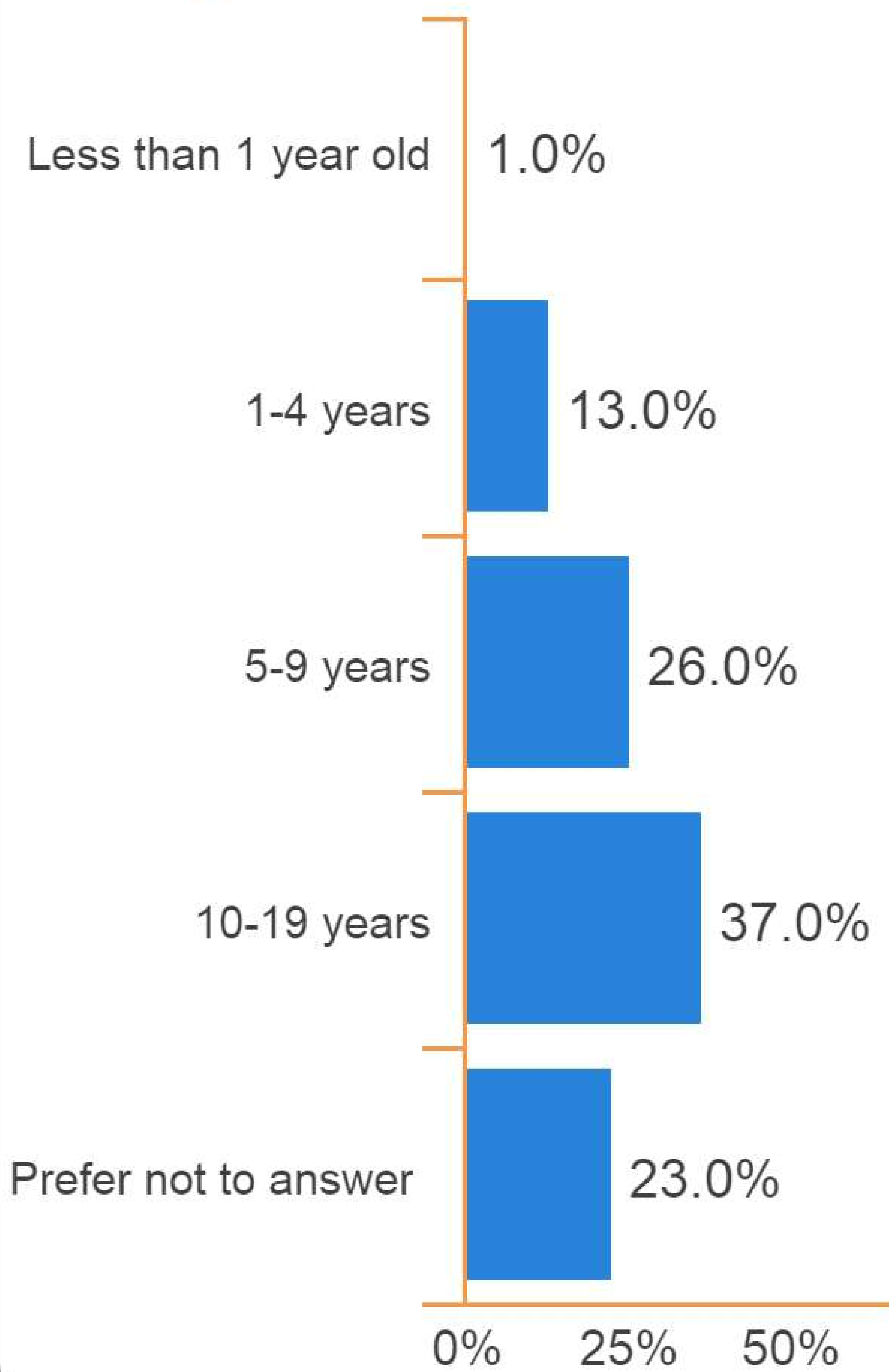

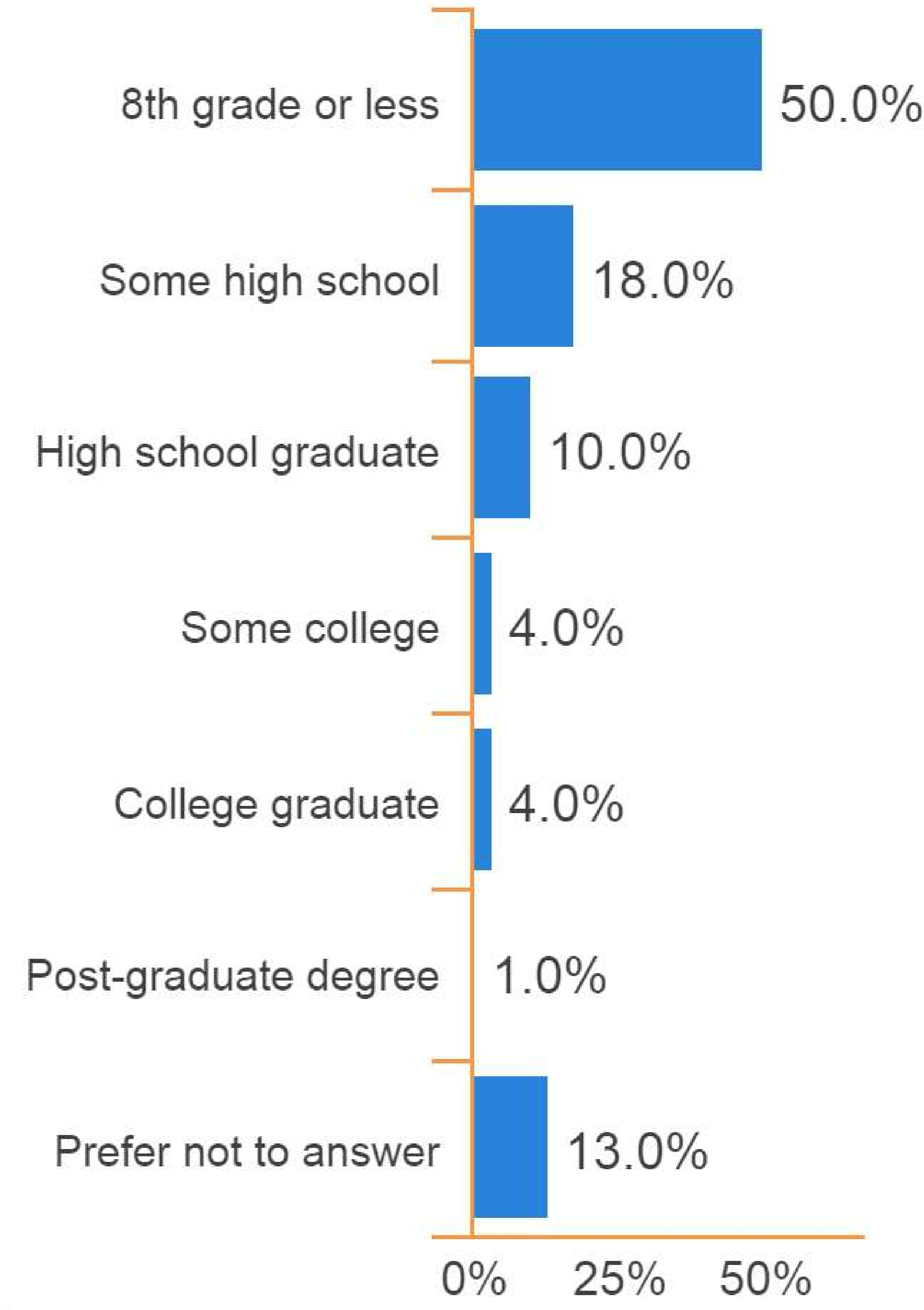

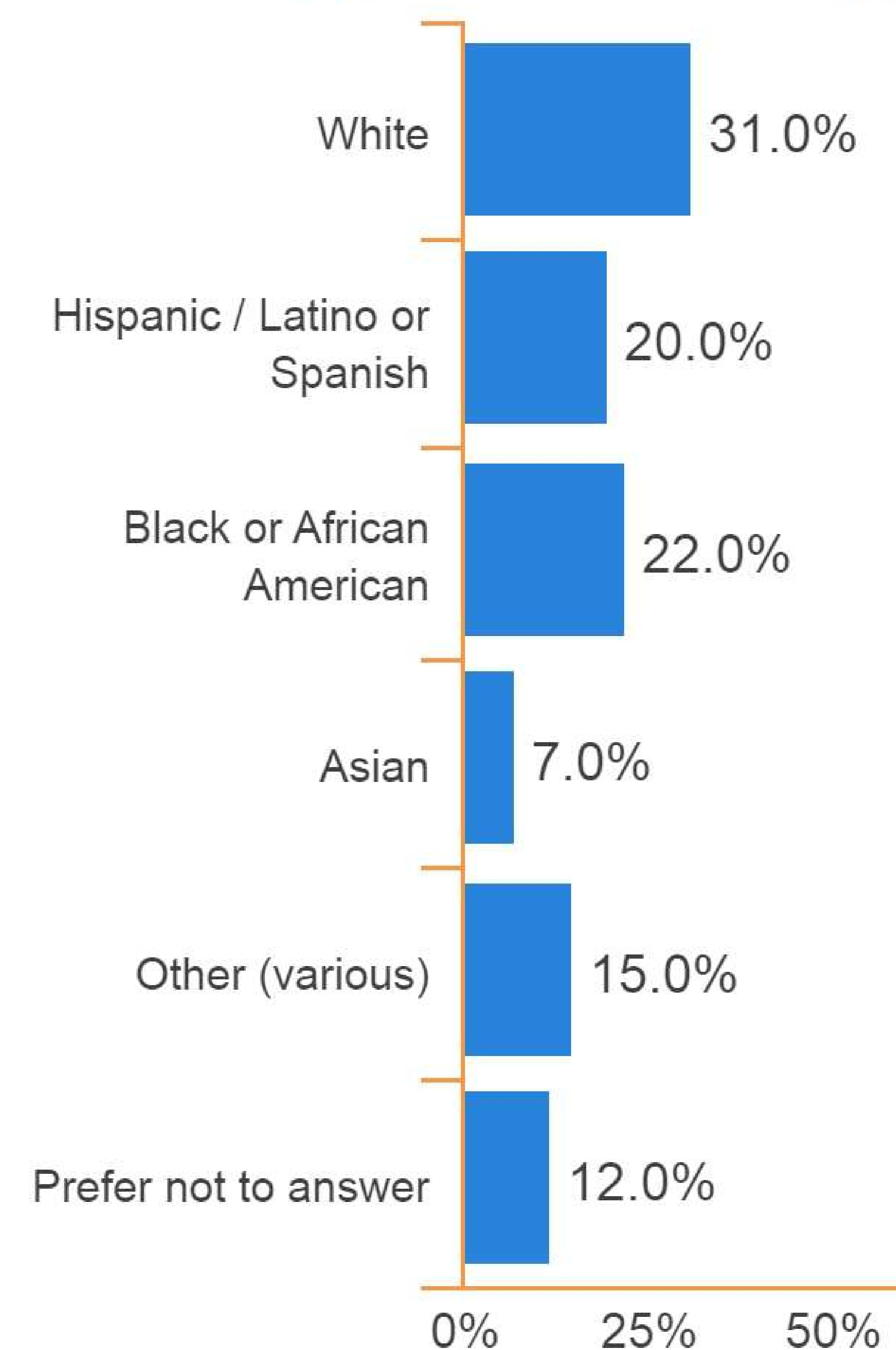

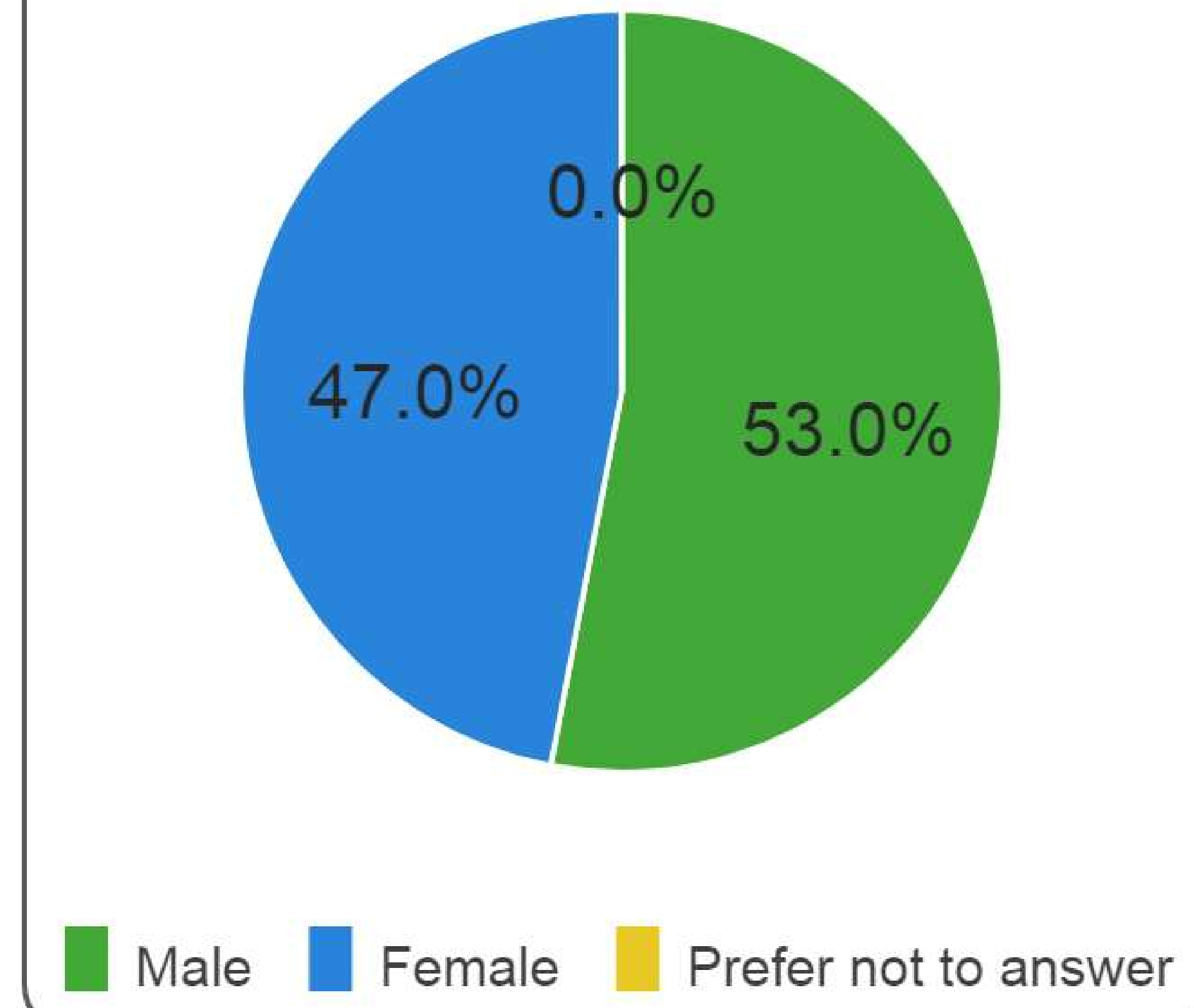

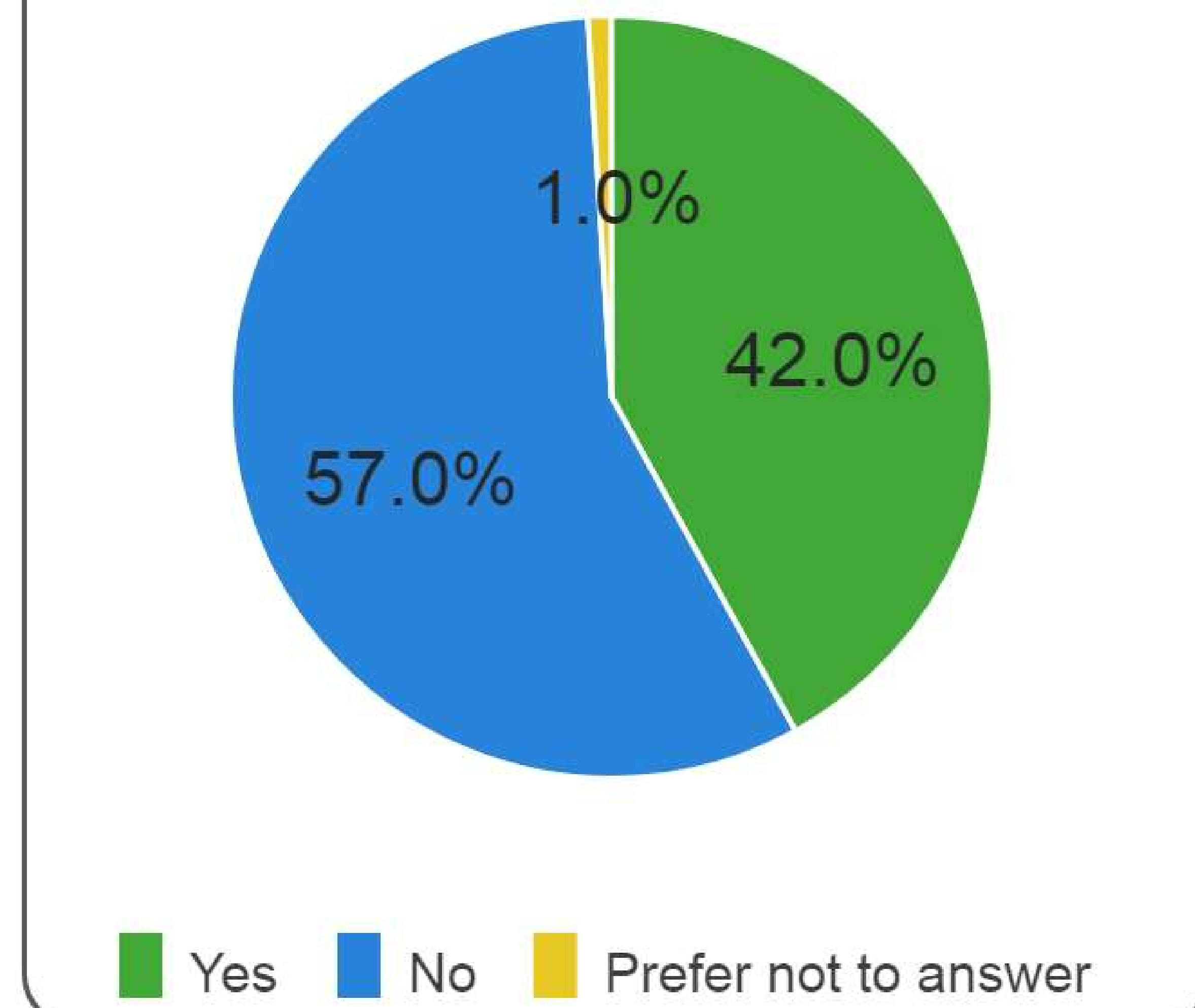

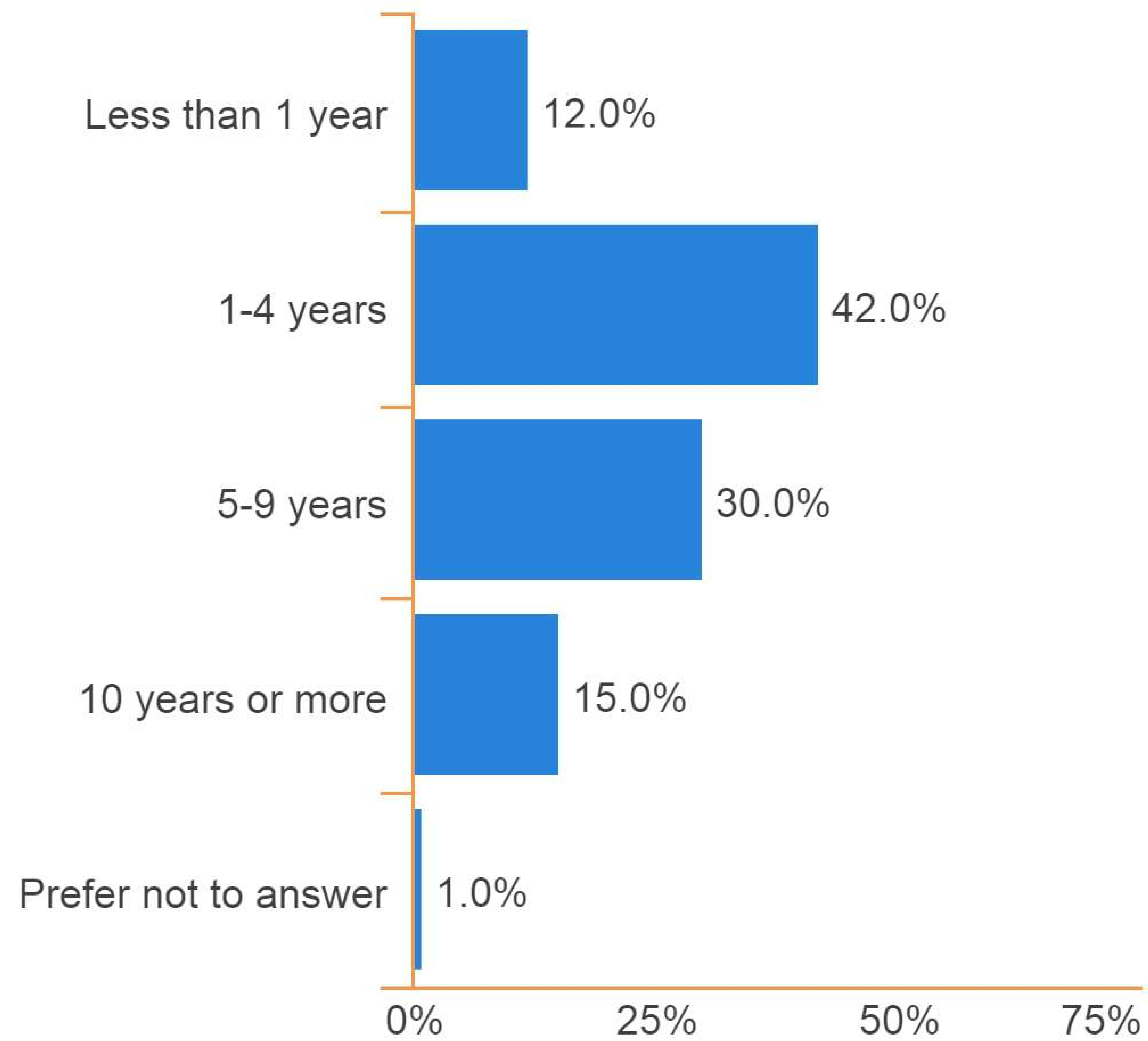

Number of Doctor Visits in Past Year

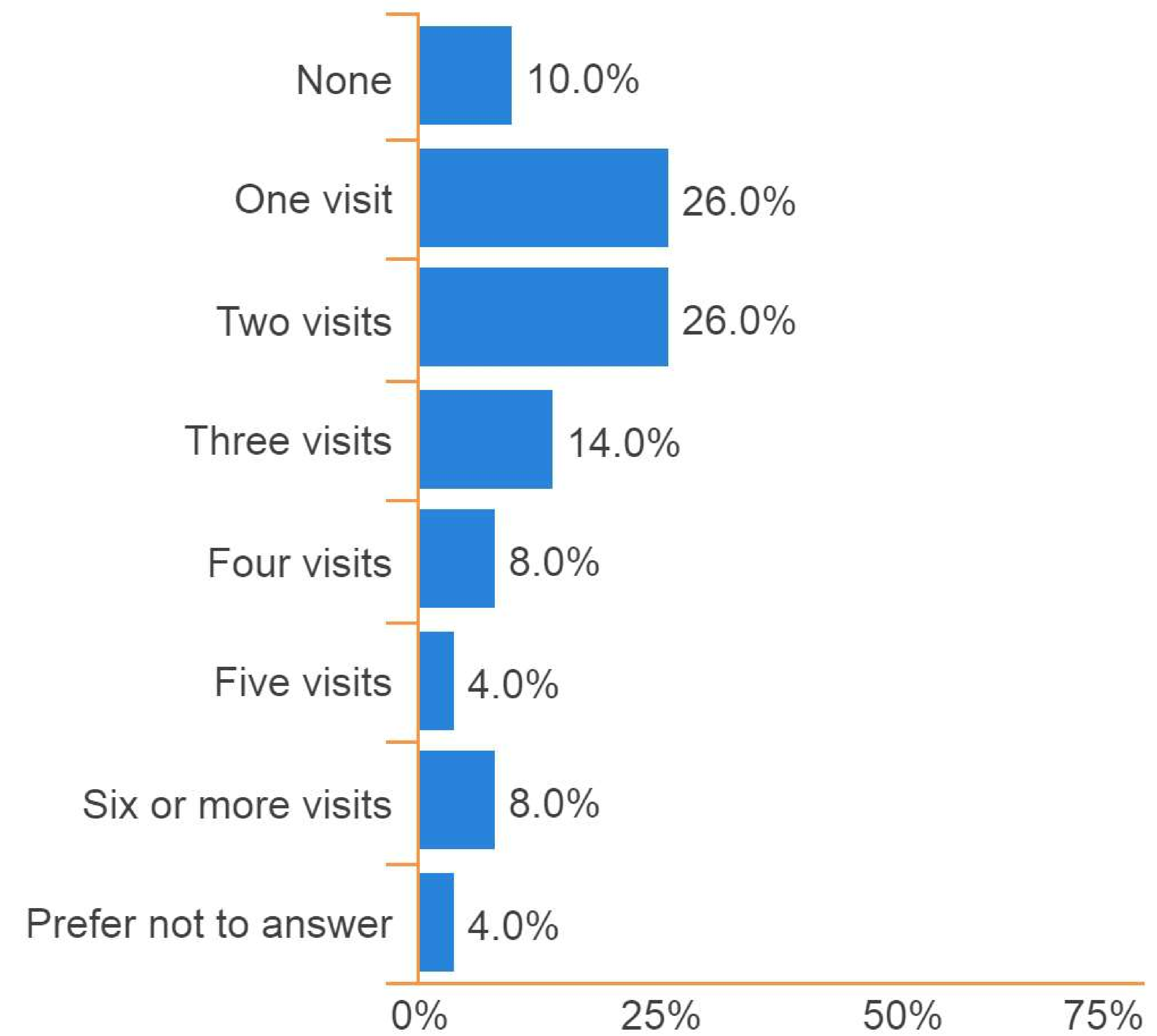

Key Study Findings - Adult

- Adult survey respondents attributed to United Community & Family Services provided lower ratings for all eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to the adult composite, resulting in an overall average score of 76.9%.
- The highest rated characteristic among United Community & Family Services respondents was recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (88.0%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (55.0%).
- Adult survey respondents ages 20-29 (89.7%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents ages 30-39 provided the lowest average rating (68.8%).
- Men (78.2%) provided a higher average rating as compared to women (76.6%).
- Those respondents identifying as Asian (97.0%) provided the highest overall average rating, while those respondents identifying as Hispanic provided the lowest average rating (73.6%).

Key Study Findings - Adult

- Survey respondents with a post-graduate degree (100.0%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents with some high school education provided the lowest average rating (63.6%).
- Adult survey respondents who have been with United Community & Family Services for 10 years or more (78.1%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have been with United Community & Family Services for 5-9 years provided the lowest average rating (72.3%).
- Adult survey respondents with four (4) visits to United Community & Family Services within the past year (93.5%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents with five (5) visits to their medical provider within the past year provided the lowest average rating (64.9%).

Key Study Findings - Child

- Child survey respondents attributed to United Community & Family Services provided lower ratings for six (6) of eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to the child composite, resulting in an overall average score of 84.5%.
- The highest rated characteristics among United Community & Family Services respondents were recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (92.0%) and “the care I get takes into account knowledge of my family” (92.0%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (60.0%).
- United Community & Family Services child respondents less than 1 year old (100.0%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents 10-19 years old provided the lowest average rating (81.8%).
- Girls attributed to United Community & Family Services (88.2%) provided a slightly higher average rating as compared to boys (81.1%).
- Asian respondents (89.6%) provided the highest overall average rating, while those respondents identifying as Hispanic provided the lowest average rating (78.2%).

Key Study Findings - Child

- Child survey respondents who have been with United Community & Family Services for 10 years or more (90.9%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have been with United Community & Family Services for less than 1 year provided the lowest average rating (81.1%).
- Child survey respondents with six (6) or more visits to United Community & Family Services within the past year (94.3%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents with three (3) visits to their medical provider within the past year provided the lowest average rating (75.3%).

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Adult Primary Care Experience

Adult survey respondents attributed to United Community & Family Services provided lower ratings for all eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to the adult composite, resulting in an overall average score of 76.9%. The highest rated characteristic among United Community & Family Services respondents was recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (88.0%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (55.0%).
