Notice of Proposed Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA)

SPA 22-AJ: Section 1915(i) Portion of the Connecticut Home Care Program for Elders – Rate Increases Related to Increase in State Minimum Wage

The State of Connecticut Department of Social Services (DSS) proposes to submit the following Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

Changes to Medicaid State Plan

Effective on or after July 1, 2022, SPA 22-AJ will amend Attachment 4.19-B of the Medicaid State Plan to increases the rates by 5.2% for the following Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes within the state plan home and community-based services option under section 1915(i) of the Social Security Act portion of the Connecticut Home Care Program for Elders (CHCPE): 1021Z, 1022Z, 1023Z, 1200Z, 1201Z, 1202Z, 1206Z, 1210Z, 1213M, 1213M, 1214Z, 1225Z, 1226Z, 1228Z, 1230Z, 1232Z, 1244Z, 1430Z, 1431Z, 1432Z, 1433Z, 1434Z, 3022Z, 3024Z, 3025Z, 3026Z, 3027Z, 3027Z, and 3028Z. The purpose of this SPA is to reflect that providers of specified section 1915(i) CHCPE services have increased costs in paying higher wages to certain staff in order to comply with the July 1, 2022 increase in the state's minimum wage.

Fiscal Impact

DSS estimates that this SPA will increase annual aggregate expenditures by \$168,508 in State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2023 and \$183,827 in SFY 2024.
