COVID-19 Agency Update April 19, 2020

The Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) Healthcare Center currently has no COVID-19 positive Veteran Patients. There have been no new COVID-19 cases in the DVA Residential Program during the previous 48 hours. There are currently six Veteran Residents who are COVID-19 positive and are being cared for in our Isolation Unit at our Rocky Hill Campus. One other Veteran Resident remains in the Isolation Unit as they presented with COVID-19 symptoms and, while their COVID-19 test was negative, CDC guidelines require additional isolation time. Three Veteran Residents are currently being treated for COVID-19 related complications in community based hospitals and two Veteran Residents, who recovered from COVID-19 in a community hospital, are in physical therapy/rehabilitation programs.

To date, no DVA staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. DVA Staff continue to follow the DVA Enhanced Safety and Health COVID-19 Protocols which are reviewed daily and adjusted based on CDC and Public Health updated directives, guidance and best practices.
