INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR VETERAN FLAG ON CONNECTICUT DRIVER'S LICENSE, IDENTITY CARD AND ON VEHICLE LICENSE PLATE FOR MEMBERS OF THE HMONG LAOTIAN SPECIAL GUERRILLA UNITS

In accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. section 14-20b and Public Act No. 21-51 members of the Hmong Laotian Special Guerrilla Units, with verified qualifying service, are eligible to receive the Veterans' identifier and U.S. flag on their driver's license or identity card and on their vehicle license plate.

Use the attached application to apply to add the Veterans' designation and U.S. Flag to your existing Connecticut driver's license, identity card or vehicle license plate. Driver's license applications must be received no later than 30 days prior to the expiration date of your license.

HOW TO APPLY: In order to receive the Veterans' designation and U.S. Flag on an existing Connecticut driver's license, identity card or vehicle license plate the applicant must submit the following:

- 1. Complete and signed application.
- 2. Personal statement explaining your time of service as a member of the Special Guerrilla Units.
- 3. Sworn statement(s) of any person(s) with firsthand knowledge of your service as a member of the Special Guerrilla Units.
- 4. Copy of any military and/or clinical documents substantiating your time of service as a member of the Special Guerrilla Units.

<u>REVIEW AND APPROVAL</u>: The Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) will review applications and based on the information provided therein will make an eligibility determination. Approved applicants will receive a Certification of Eligibility from the DVA to provide to the Department of Motor Vehicles. Disapproved applicants will receive a letter explaining the deficiencies in their application and will be provided an opportunity to resubmit their application.

I understand that failure to provide the requested information may result in the inability to verify eligibility based on the lack of sufficient information and unverified eligibility will result in the denial and return of this application. By submitting this form, I attest that the information provided, including the attached documents, are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that intentionally including false or inaccurate information is a criminal act punishable as a Class A Misdemeanor pursuant to C.G.S. §53a-157b.
