

There exists between Clinton and Trinity Streets in Hartford a 12 foot wide gangway which I own in connection with the State of Connecticut and the owners of the properties at 91, 93 and 95 Elm Street.

On repeated occasions I have requested that the State not block this gangway and a previous agreement had been reached to eliminate the parking at the west end of the gangway. This parking reduces the available width to approximately six feet, which, with the snow, barely permits small vehicles ingress and egress.

Please consider this to be my written request that you honor the gangway rights which we share and cease and desist from parking within the 12 foot width.

Your continued usage of this space as designated parking for State employees is violative of our communal right of way.

Thank you for your immediate attention to this matter.
