

About the Grants

The State of Connecticut Nonprofit Security Grant Program (CT-NSGP) and The Federal Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP-S) provide funding to vulnerable nonprofits that are at risk of a terrorist attack, hate crime, or violent act. Both the NSGP-S and the CT-NSGP provide funding for security infrastructure improvements. The NSGP-S additionally provides funding for emergency planning, training, and security personnel.
