## General Statutes Sects. 53a-213a & 213b

- Neither drivers nor passengers can smoke in a motor vehicle.
- BUT Subsection (c) of both: This cannot be the SOLE reason that the vehicle is stopped.
- NEW AMENDMENT To Subsection (c) (Effective Oct. 1, 2025):
- "No peace officer shall stop a motor vehicle for a violation of [these statutes] if a violation is the sole reason for such stop, <u>unless such officer (1)</u> <u>observes active cannabis consumption by the</u> <u>OPERATOR of the motor vehicle, and (2) detects</u> <u>the odor of burnt cannabis."</u>
