 - 03. The file storage area consists of high-density shelving or and a secure, locking file cabinet or room.
 - 04. Converted film/Polaroid/negatives to digital media will be backed up in secure high capacity storage device and a hard copy will be preserved on CD/DVD in the appropriate file area.
 - 05. All stored/archived film/negatives/digital media will be cataloged in the areas database and this database will be routinely backed up to a secure network server.
