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Family Violence Summary 2023

- Family violence incidents reported by police in 2023 totaled 16,023, a decrease of 2.6 percent compared to the 16,457 reported in 2022.
- The 16,023 reported family violence incidents involved 33,952 participants.
- There were 24 family violence homicide incidents resulting in 25 victims.
- Reported offenses equaled 26,405
- Females were the victim of 67.2 percent of all offenses (17,749); males were the victim of 32.8 percent of all offenses (8,656).
- Individuals in a dating relationship were most commonly participants in family violence incidents.
- Intimate partner arrest incidents accounted for 75.6 percent of total family violence arrest incidents.
- Intimate partner dual arrest incidents accounted for 7.2 percent of total family violence arrest incidents.
- Intimate partner dual arrest incidents accounted for 9.5 percent of total intimate partner arrest incidents.
- A weapon was used in 60.3 percent of family violence incidents.
- An injury was sustained by 34.0 percent of family violence victims.
- The most frequent time of day of family violence incidents was between 6:00 pm and 11:59 p.m.
- The most frequent day of family violence occurrences was Sunday.
- The most frequent month of family violence occurrences was July.
- The age cohort of 30-34 years had the highest number of family violence participants.
- There were no court orders of protection in place in 74.5 percent of family violence incidents.
- Children less than 18 years of age were involved in 1,607 incidents.
- New Haven had the largest number of reported family violence arrest incidents, 1,693.
- New Haven had the highest incident rate per 100,000 population, 1,197.
- Norwich had the highest offense rate per 100,000 population, 2,318

Overview

The 2023 Family Violence Arrest Report contains information on the number of family violence arrests which were reported to the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, State Police Division, Crimes Analysis Unit, by Connecticut law enforcement agencies prior to May 20, 2024. As defined in Connecticut General Statute 46b-38d(b), "Each police department, including resident troopers and constables, shall report all family violence incidents where an arrest occurs to the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection, who shall compile statistics of family violence crimes and cause them to be published annually in the Connecticut Uniform Crime Report."

Police in Connecticut are required to make an arrest whenever they respond to a call that involves family violence and there is enough probable cause to affect an arrest. As defined in Connecticut General Statute 46b-38a(1), "Family violence" means an incident resulting in physical harm, bodily injury or assault, or an act of threatened violence that constitutes fear of imminent physical harm, bodily injury, or assault, including, but not limited to, stalking or a pattern of threatening, between family or household members. Verbal abuse or argument shall not constitute family violence unless there is present danger and the likelihood that physical violence will occur. "Family violence crime" does not include acts by parents or guardians disciplining minor children unless such acts constitute abuse.

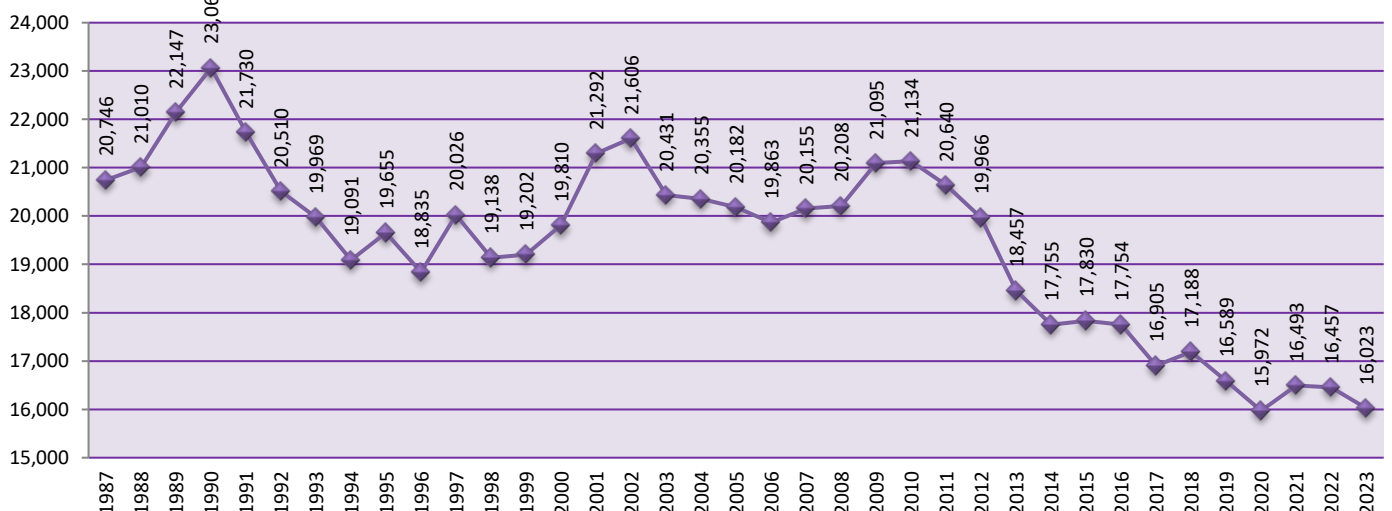
According to Connecticut General Statute 46b-38a(2), "Family or household member" means any of the following persons, regardless of the age of such person: (A) Spouses or former spouses; (B) parents or their children; (C) persons related by blood or marriage; (D) persons other than those persons described in subparagraph (C) of this subdivision presently residing together or who have resided together; (E) persons who have a child in common regardless of whether they are or have been married or have lived together at any time; and (F) persons in, or who have recently been in, a dating relationship.

ANALYSIS

Volume 1987 - 2023

There were 16,023 reported incidents of family violence during 2023. This represents a decrease of 2.6 percent (434) from the number reported in 2022 (16,457).

Participants

A review of the 16,023 family violence arrest incidents shows that there were 33,952 participants. A total of 16,231 individuals were identified as victims. A closer look at the victim total shows that 11,202 victims were female (69.0 percent) and 5,029 were male (31.0 percent). There were 14,545 individuals identified as offenders. Of the offender total, females accounted for 3,881 (26.7 percent), while males accounted for 10,664 (73.3 percent). Also, 3,176 individuals were identified as both victim and offender (i.e., dual arrest incidents). Of the individuals identified as both victim and offender, 1,605 were female (50.5 percent), while 1,571 were male (50.5 percent).

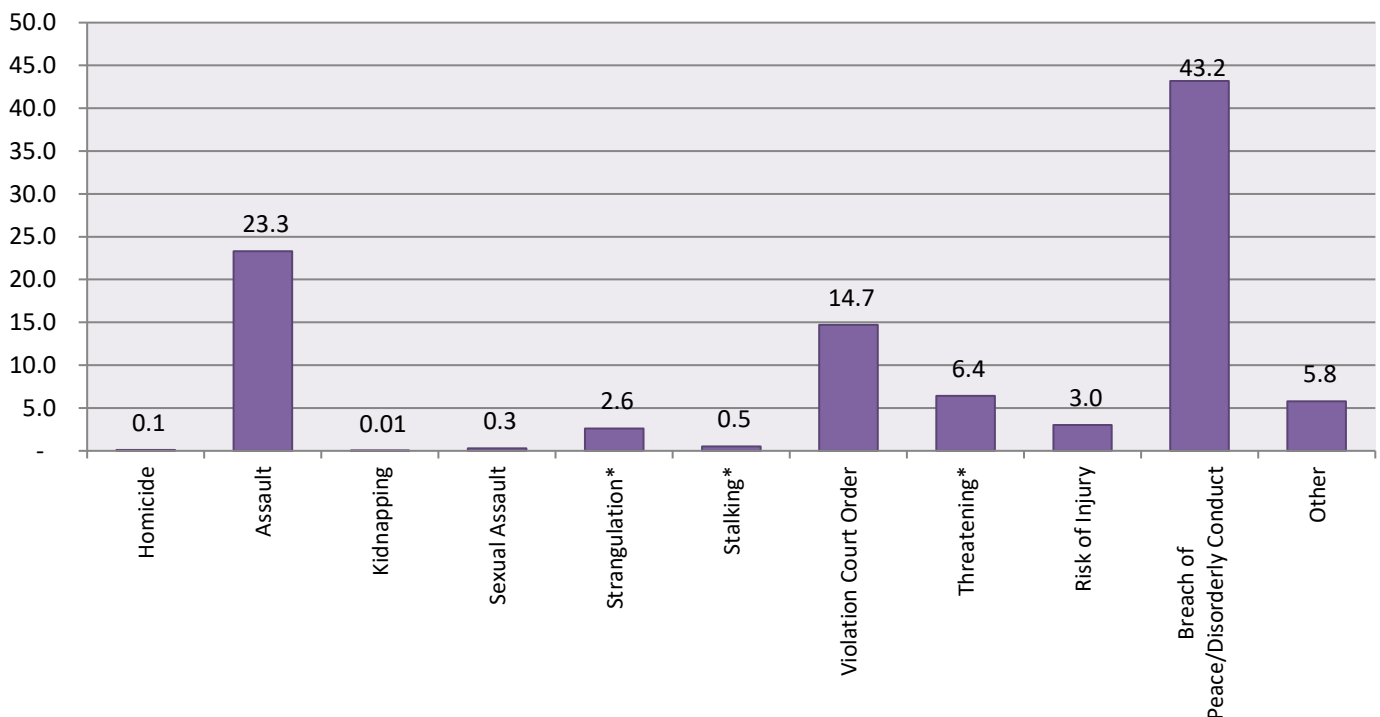
Offenses

Due to policy changes designed to strengthen family violence data, beginning with 2014 all victim offenses occurring in family violence arrests are counted. In previous years, one offense type was recorded for each incident following a hierarchy rule to ensure the most serious offense was counted. Also, there are several changes in the offense categories on the Family Violence Offense Report, form DPS-230-C (Appendix 1), the form that is submitted to DESPP when a family violence arrest is made.

New offenses beginning in 2014 include stalking, strangulation, and threatening. Offenses combined on the revised version of form DPS-230-C are breach of peace and disorderly conduct. Offenses that were previously combined and are now individually counted are violation of court order and other. Offenses with no change are homicide, assault, kidnapping, sexual assault, and risk of injury. While not affecting the incident total, these changes increased the total number of reported offenses making the offense count incomparable to previous years.

During 2023, the family violence offenses equaled 26,405. Breach of peace/disorderly conduct was the most common family violence offense (11,405) accounting for 43.2 percent of total offenses. The second most common offense was assault (6,157), 23.3 percent of all offenses, followed by violation court order (3,888), 14.7 percent.

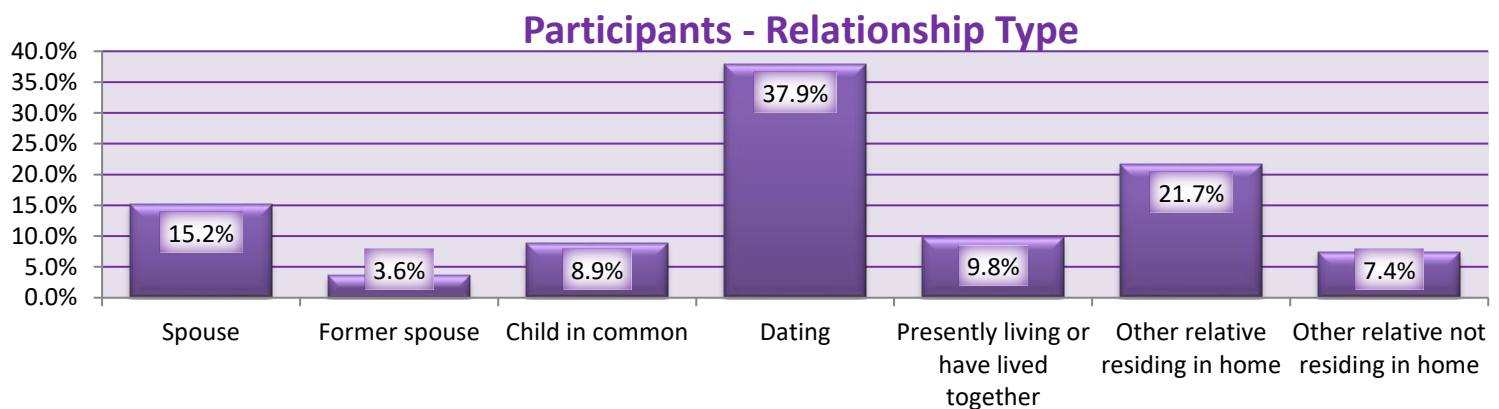

Relationships

During 2023, individuals in a dating relationship were most commonly participants in family violence incidents, 37.9 percent of total incidents (6,067). Following were other relatives residing in home, 21.7 percent of total incidents (3,481), and spouse 15.2 percent of total incidents (2,442). In incidents involving more than one relationship type, all relationship types are counted in the following table.

Intimate Partner Incidents – Intimate Partner Dual Arrest Incidents

Intimate partner arrest incidents (12,119) accounted for 75.6 percent of total family violence arrest incidents (16,023) during 2023, down from 76.5 percent in 2022. Intimate partner dual arrest incidents (1,154) accounted for 7.2 percent of total family violence arrest incidents (16,023) during 2023, up from 7.1 percent in 2022. Intimate partner dual arrest incidents (1,154) accounted for 9.5 percent of total intimate partner arrest incidents (12,119) during 2023, up from 9.3 percent in 2022.

A dual arrest is when police cannot determine which participants in an incident are at fault, or think all participants people are guilty, they arrest all participants.

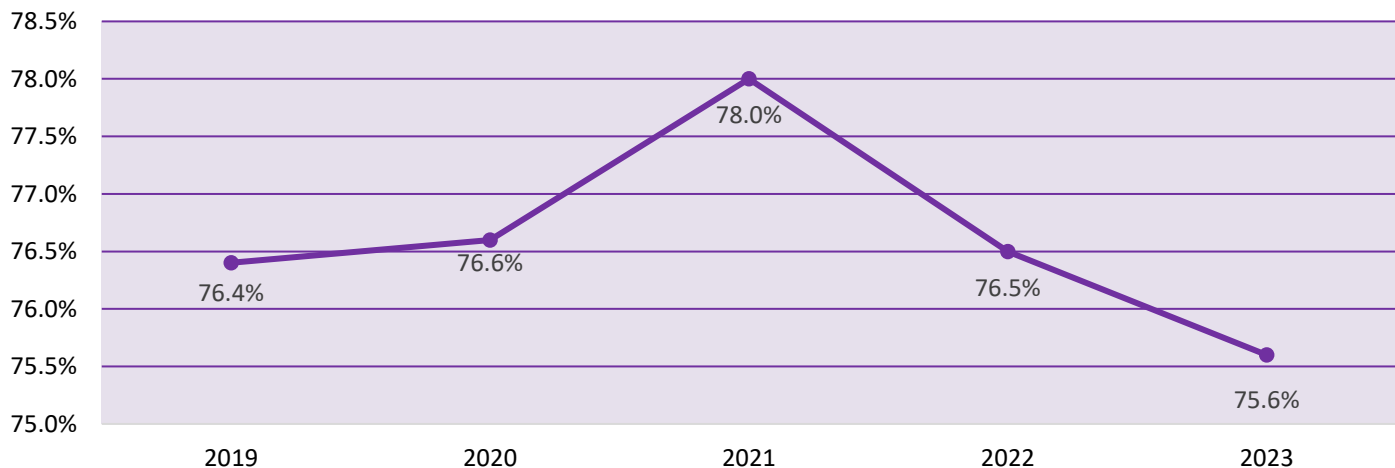

TOTAL FAMILY VIOLENCE ARREST INCIDENTS - INTIMATE PARTNER DUAL ARREST INCIDENTS

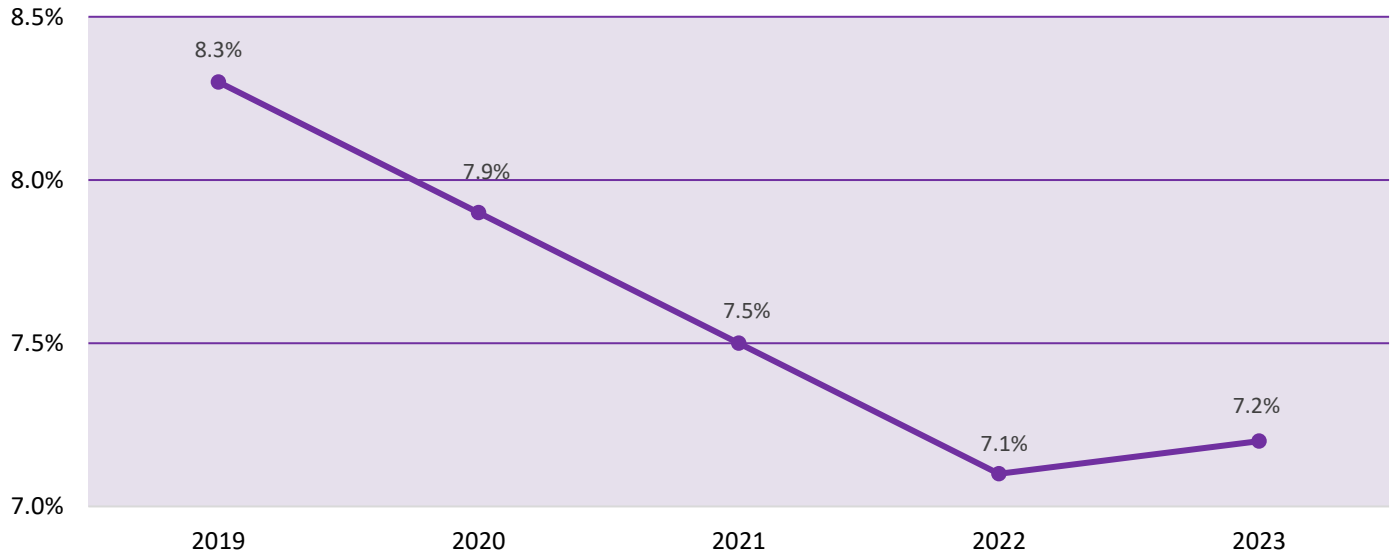

Intimate Partner Dual Arrest Incidents as Percent of Total Family Violence Arrest Incidents



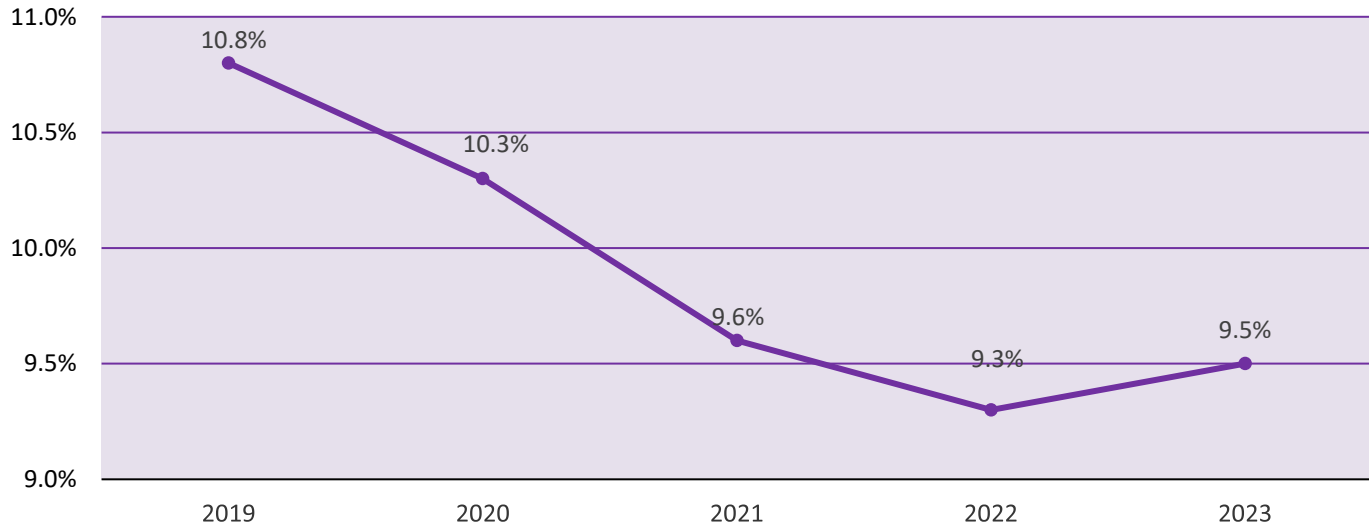

Intimate Partner Dual Arrest Incidents as Percent Total IP Arrest Incidents

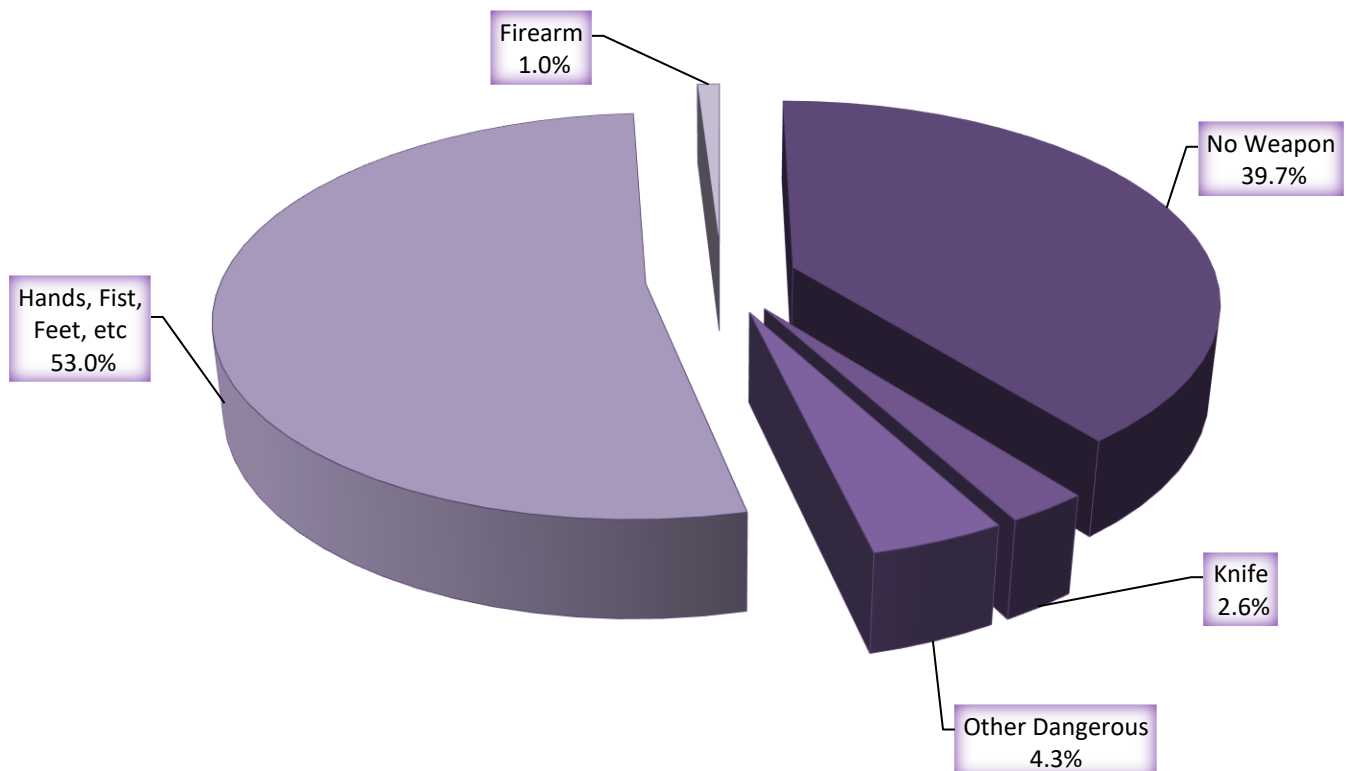


Weapons

In 2023, 9,655 or 60.3 percent of total family violence incidents involved a weapon. A weapon is defined as any object, instrument, device, or part of the anatomy used in an attack. In an incident involving more than one weapon, all weapons used are counted. When weapons were involved, hands, fist, feet, or other parts of the anatomy were used in a larger number of incidents than any other weapon classification, 8,485 or 53.0 percent of total incidents. Persons in a dating relationship were more often the victim in a family violence incident involving hands, fist, feet, or other parts of the anatomy than any other relationship type. Firearms were used as a weapon in 158 incidents, 1.0 percent of total incidents.

Injury

An injury was sustained by 34.0 percent of family violence victims, with minor injury being the most common injury. An injury is classified as minor when the victim does not suffer obvious, severe, or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness. Conversely, an injury is classified as serious when the victim does suffer obvious, severe, or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness.

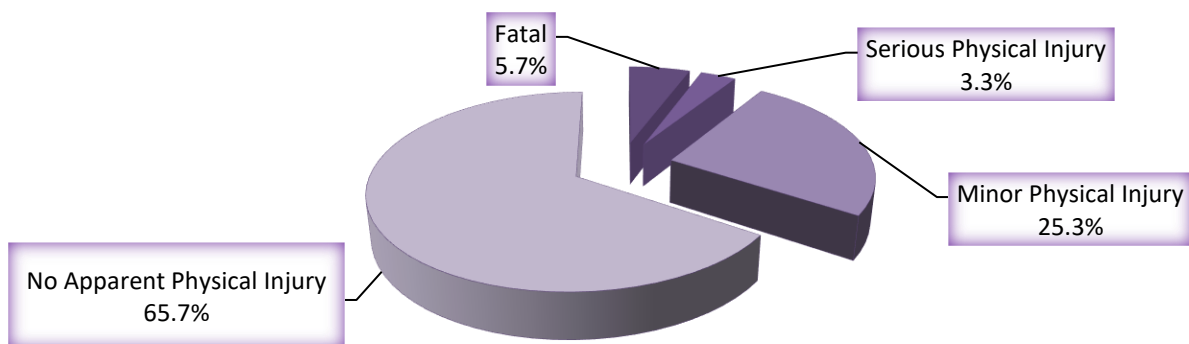
Percent Injury Type by Gender

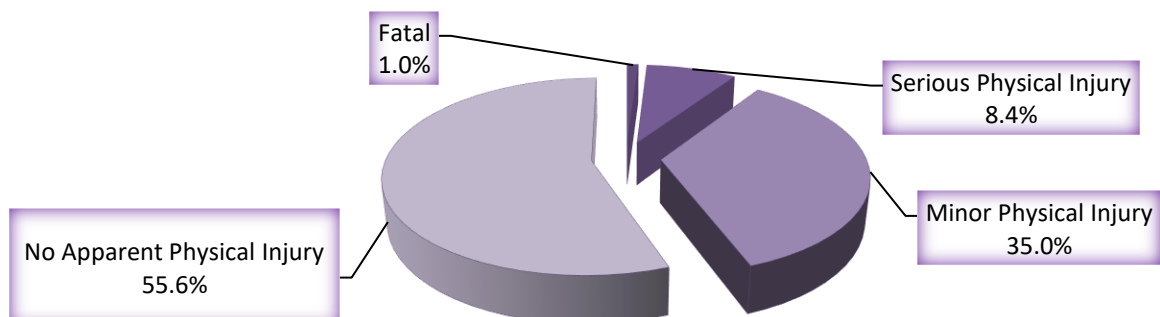

Injury Type - Incidents Involving Firearm



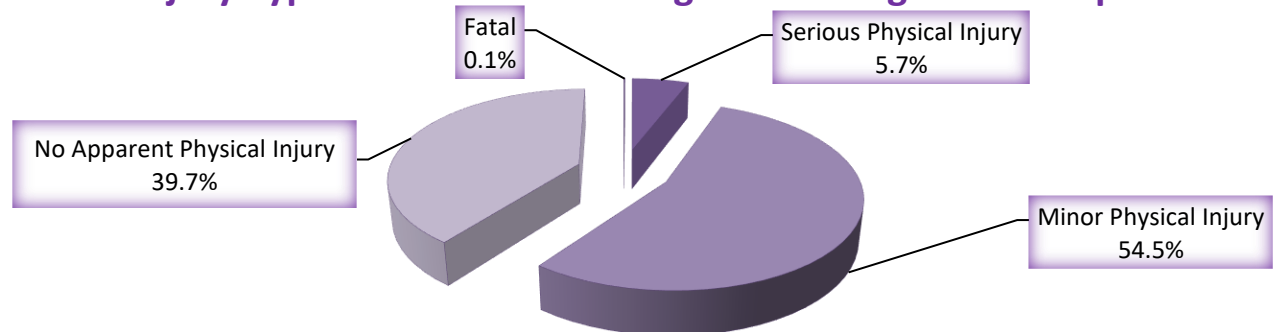

Injury Type - Incidents Involving Knife



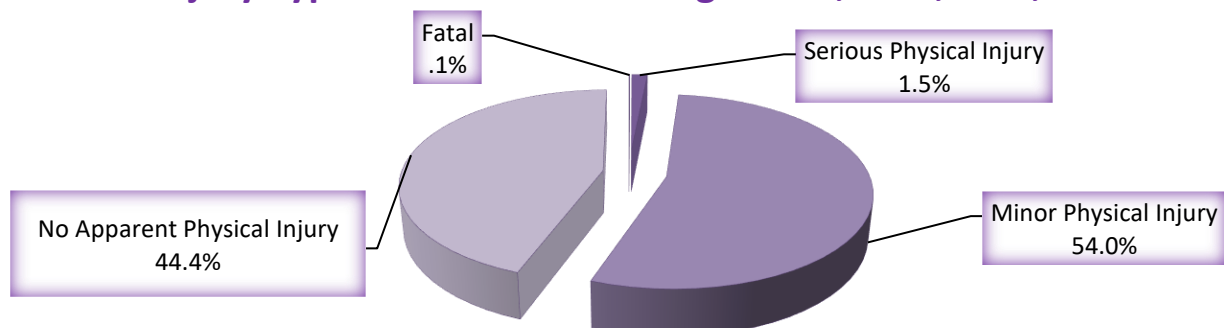

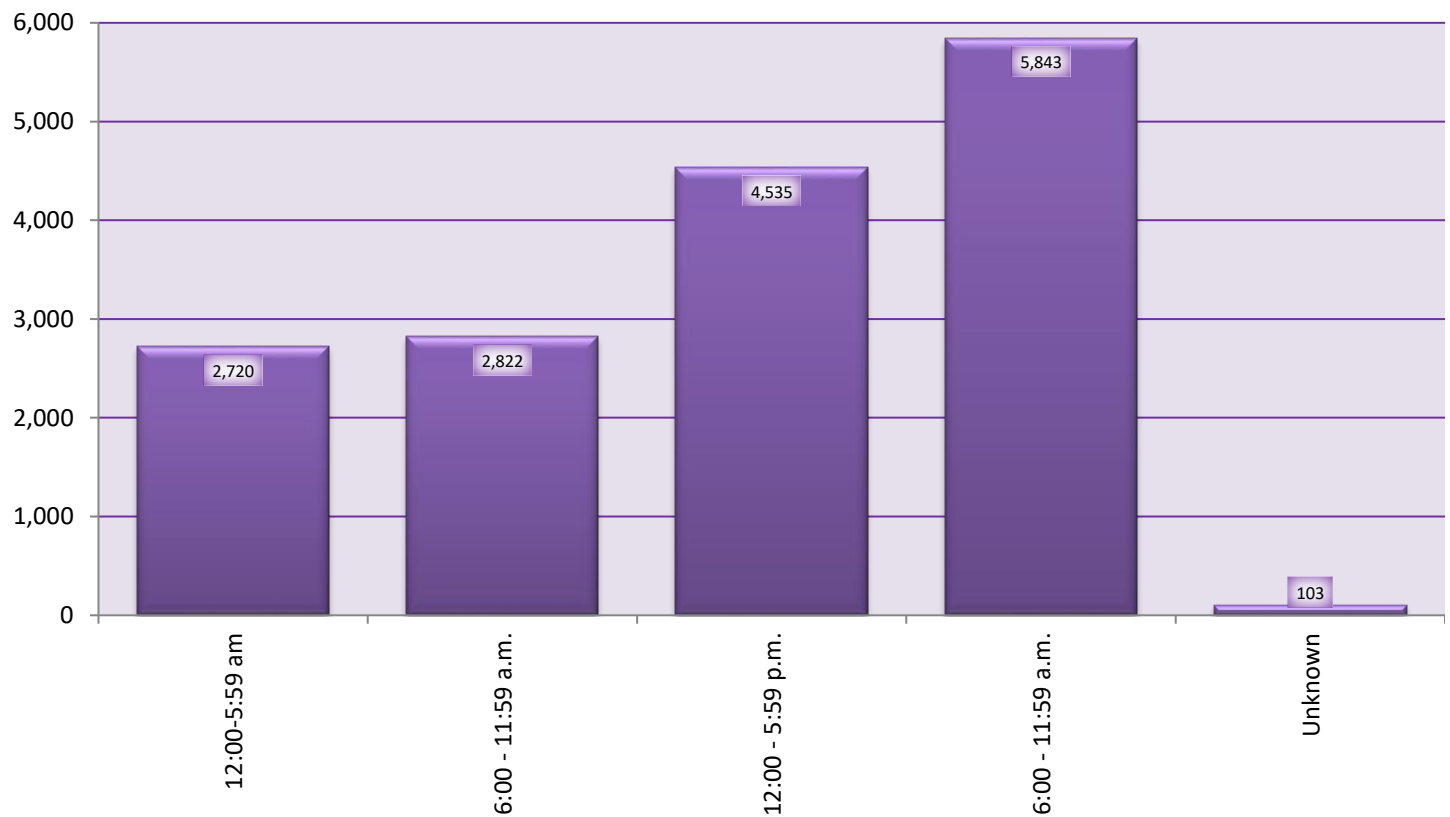
Injury Type - Incidents Involving Hands, Fists, Feet, etc.

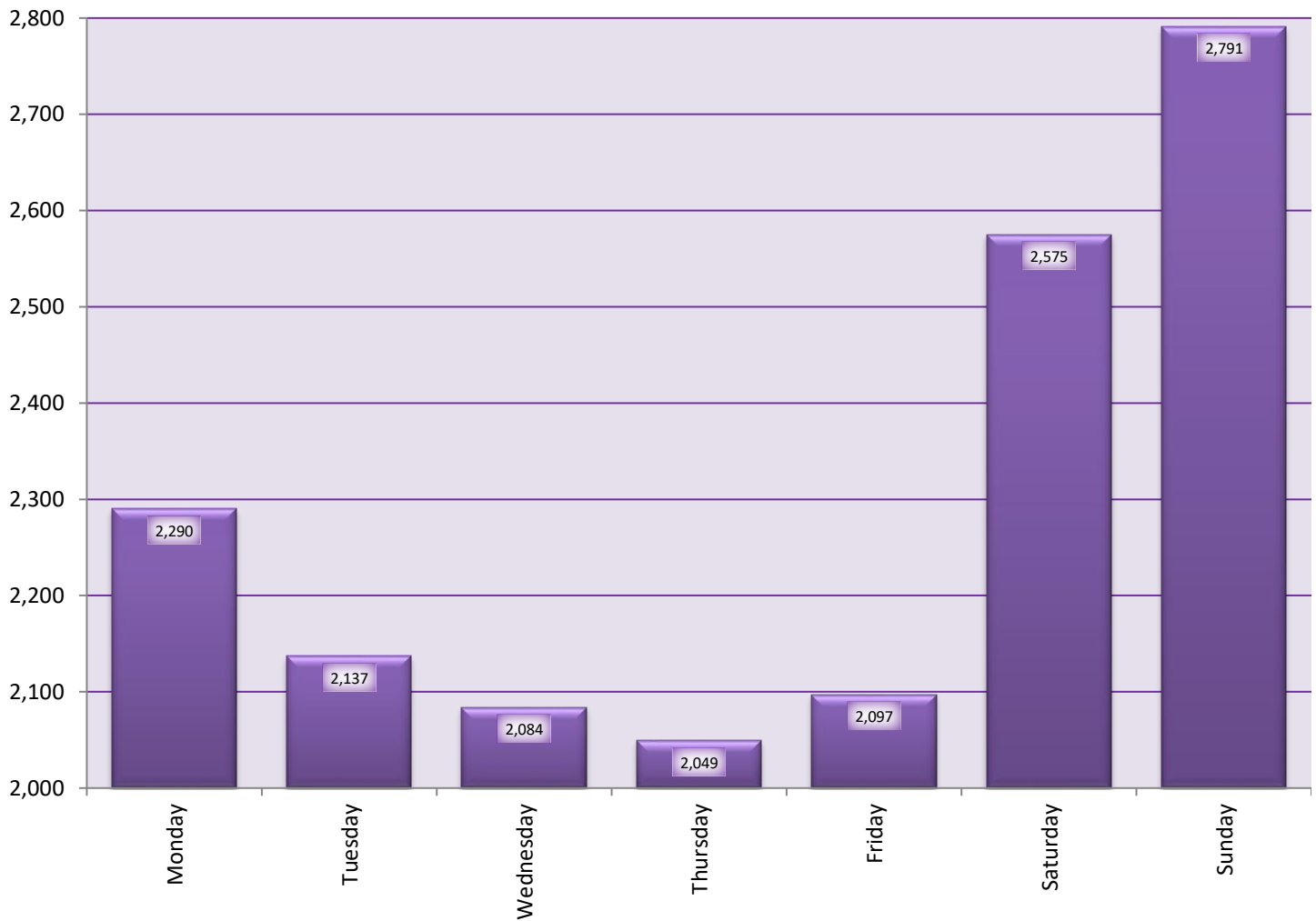
Total Incidents - Time of Day

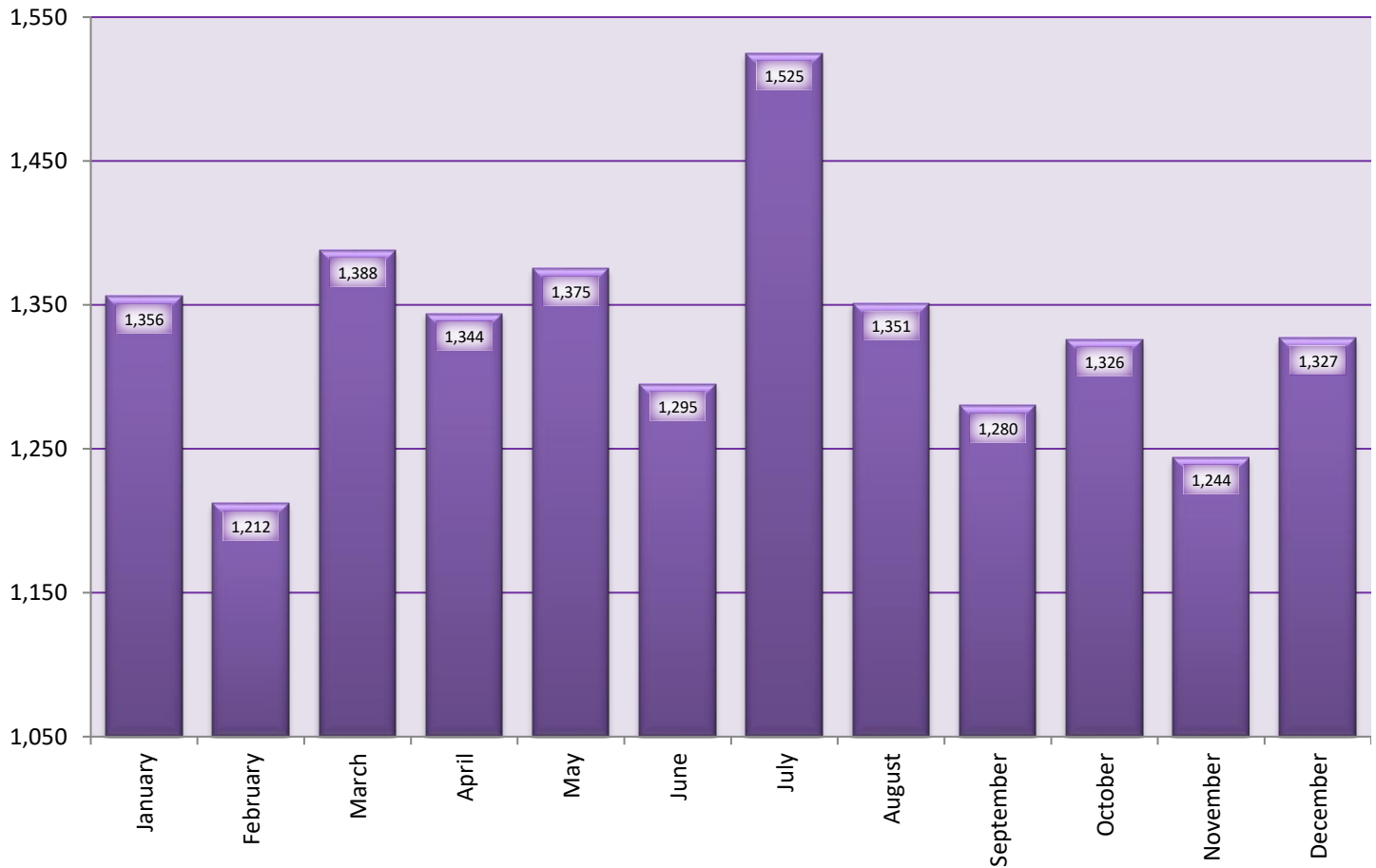
Total Incidents - Day of Week

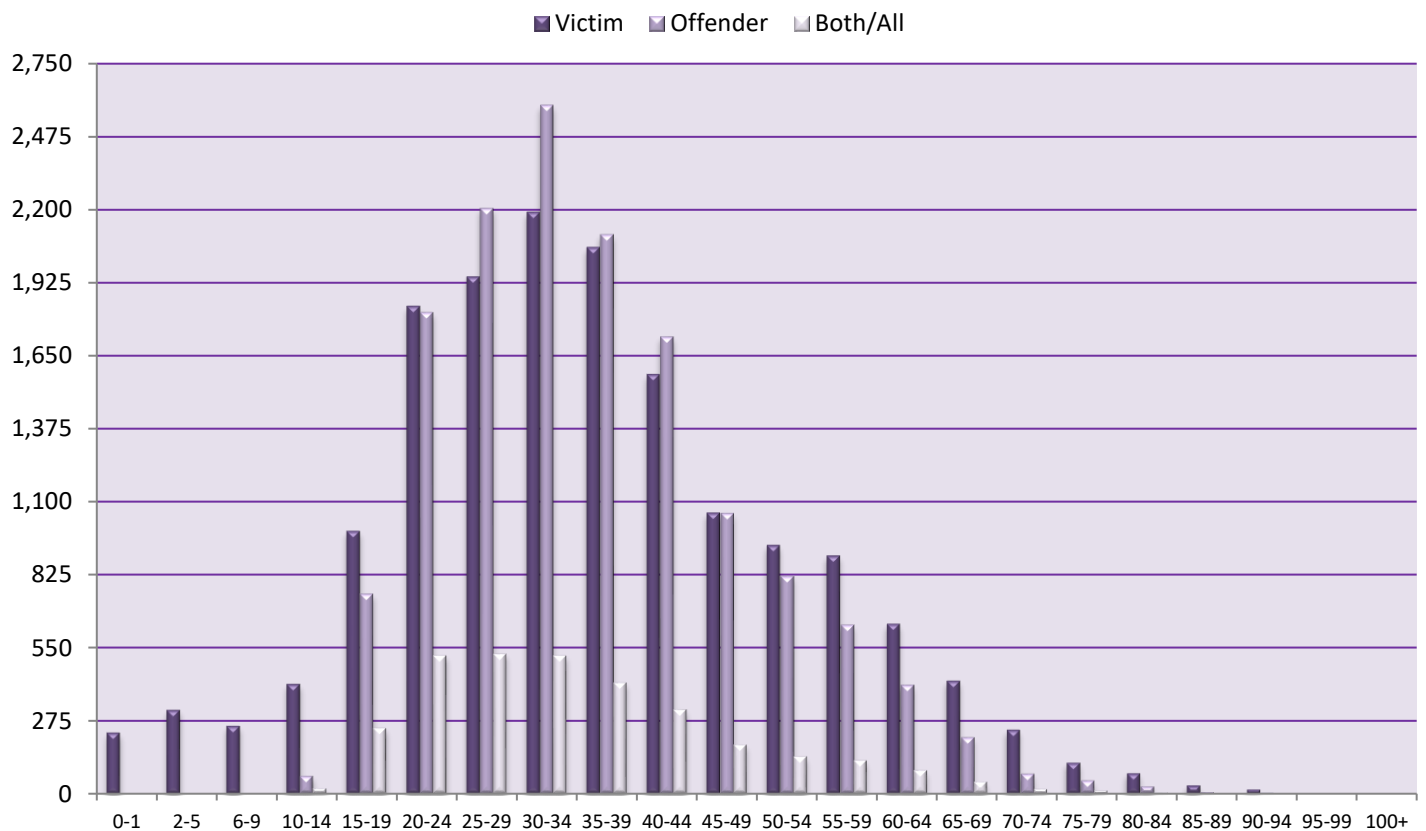
Total Incidents - Month of Year



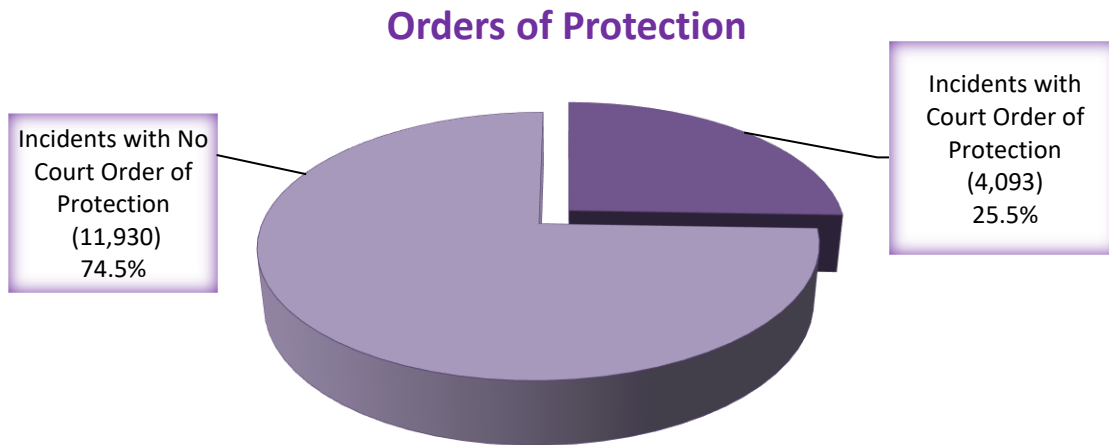

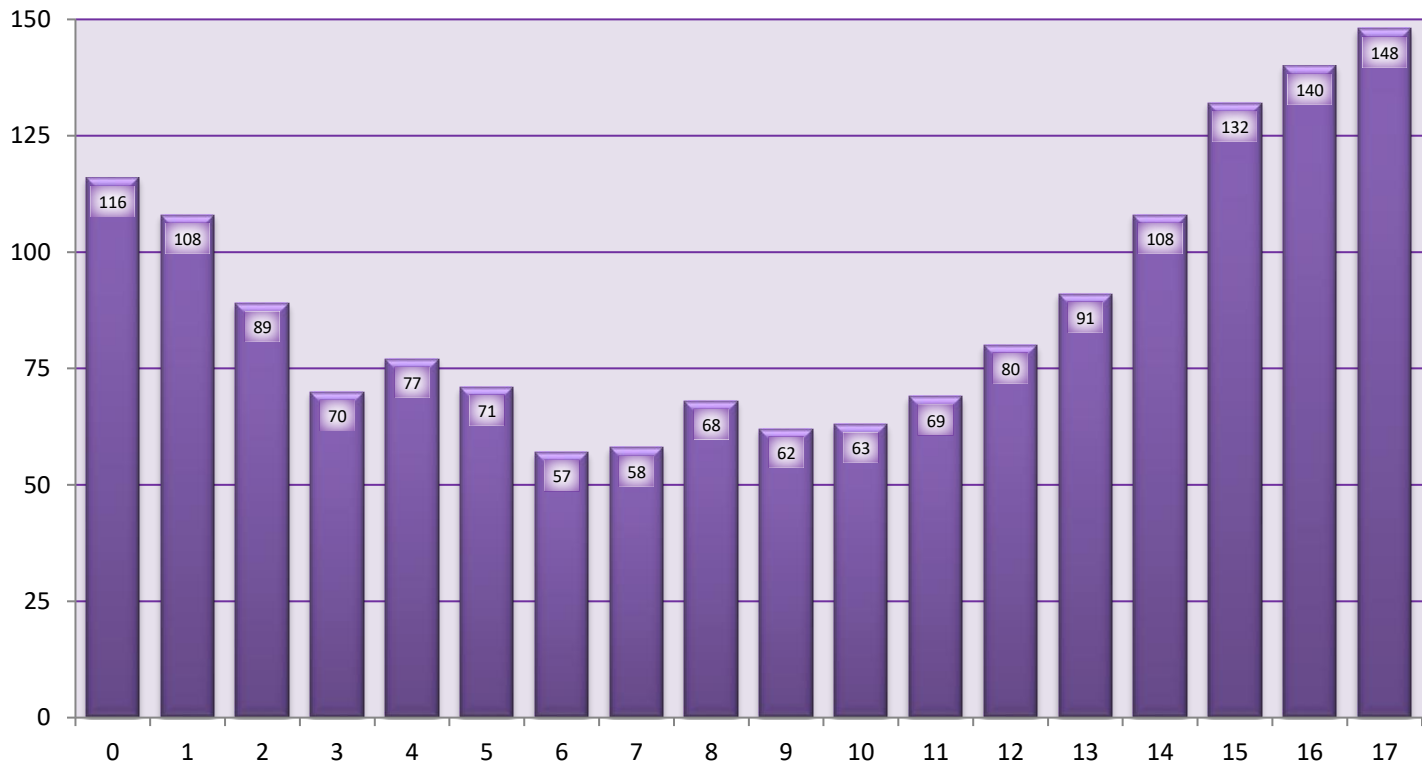
