DECISION

DECISION

I. INTRODUCTION

A. SUMMARY

Pursuant to Section 16-256g of the General Statutes of Connecticut (Conn. Gen. Stat.), the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (Authority or PURA) initiated this docket to conduct an annual proceeding to determine the monthly fee that will be assessed on each local telephone service, commercial mobile radio service (CMRS), customer-owned coin operated telephone (COCOT) service and Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) subscriber to fund the development and administration of the state's Enhanced Emergency 911 (E-911) program. The Authority reviewed the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection's (DESPP) proposed E-911 program operating budget for fiscal year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023 (FY 2023). The FY 2023 operating budget requirement is \$36,816,109. This is an increase of \$3,352,896 from the FY 2022 operating budget of \$33,463,213. As a result, Connecticut communications service customers will be assessed a monthly fee ranging from \$0.70 to \$0.14 depending upon the number of access lines, VoIP, wireless, or wireline telephone numbers subscribed, as of January 1, 2022.

B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

In accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. §§ 16-256g and 28-24 and §§ 28-24-1a et seq. of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (Conn. Agencies Regs.), the Authority, in conjunction with DESPP, directed the two local exchange companies (LECs), all competitive local exchange carriers (CLEC), CMRS wireless providers, providers of COCOT and VoIP providers (collectively, Companies) to provide their total number of access lines and active telephone numbers in-service as of January 1, 2022. The Companies were also directed to provide the number of customers subscribing to multiple lines/telephone numbers. Pursuant to Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a, DESPP is required to submit to the Authority its annual operating budget for the state's E-911 program. DESPP filed its budget submission with the Authority on April 13, 2022. On, May 16, 2022 DESPP filed a revised budget with the Authority. This information is necessary to determine the FY 2023 funding requirements to administer the state's E-911 program.

C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING

By Notice of Hearing dated March 21, 2022, the Authority announced that a public hearing would be held in this matter on April 8, 2022, if requested. The Authority did not receive any requests for a hearing and cancelled the April 8, 2022 hearing on April 4, 2022 through a schedule change notification.

The Authority issued a Proposed Final Decision in this Docket on May 18, 2022. All participants were provided an opportunity to file written exceptions on the Proposed Final Decision.

D. PARTIES AND INTERVENORS OR PARTICIPANTS

The Authority recognized DESPP, 1111 Country Club Road, Middletown, CT 06457-9294; the Office of Consumer Counsel, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, CT 06051; the Commissioner of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, 79 Elm Street, Hartford, CT 06106; all LECs, CLECs, CMRS and providers of COCOT and VoIP services in Connecticut as Participants to this proceeding. A listing of the Participants is appended hereto as Attachment A.

II. STANDARD OF REVIEW

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-256g, the Authority conducts an annual proceeding to determine the amount of the monthly fee to be assessed against each subscriber of local telephone service, commercial mobile radio service and voice over internet protocol service, to fund the enhanced emergency 9-1-1 program. The Authority bases such fees on the findings of the Commissioner of the DESPP taking into consideration any existing moneys available in the Enhanced 9-1- 1 Telecommunications Fund. Id. The Authority must not approve any fee greater than seventy-five cents per month per access line that does not include the progressive wire line inclusion schedule, or for commercial mobile radio service that includes the progressive wire line inclusion schedule. Id.

III. AUTHORITY ANALYSIS

A. 2022 - 2023 E-911 OPERATING BUDGET

On or before January 1 of each year, DESPP "prepare[s] the annual budget for the use of funds from the E 9-1-1 Telecommunications Fund and submit[s] such budget to the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management for the secretary's review and approval." Conn. Gen. Stat. § 28-24(a)(8). The budget is then submitted to the relevant joint standing committees of the General Assembly. Id. In accordance with Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a, on April 13, 2022, the DESPP provided the Authority with the approved E-911 annual operating budget (Operating Budget). The total Operating Budget requirement is \$36,816,109 for FY 2023, an increase of \$3,352,896 from the FY 2022 budget. The estimated requirements for each line item of the Operating Budget categories are detailed below.

1. 911 Systems

The cost of E-911 database services are estimated at \$950,000 for FY 2023 and include software maintenance, database management and support services. The estimated Next Generation 911 System (NG911) costs of \$10,111,802 include network management, monitoring and maintenance for the Universal Power Supply (UPS),

NG911 system, help desk services and the Public Safety Data Network. The total 911 system costs are estimated at \$11,061,802.

2. Emergency Telecommunications Services and Support

Funding for the E-911 street centerline and address data updates for FY 2023 are estimated to be \$41,000 for hardware, software and custom formatting, \$60,000 for Geographic Information System (GIS) business data and geocoding costs, and \$200,000 for a GIS orthophotography flight scheduled in 2022. The total GIS costs are estimated at \$301,000. The cost of providing translation services to all Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) is calculated to be \$55,000. CT Alert, Connecticut's emergency notification system used by both State officials for large-scale notifications, and local notifications managed by PSAPs to alert citizens of public safety threats, are assessed at \$1,234,757. Interoperability of radio systems is contingent upon the P-25 switch and is estimated at \$458,313 and public education initiatives for 9-1-1 are \$100,000.

The total cost for Emergency Telecommunications Services and Support is estimated at \$2,149,070.

3. Regional Emergency Telecommunications Funding

The funding requirement for the Regional Emergency Telecommunications Centers (RECC) is based on a formula provided in Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-3a and results in an exact amount required for this budget category. The total funding requirement is \$6,216,046 for the five RECCs for FY 2023. ¹

4. Funding for Cities with Populations Over 40,000

Funding for the 22 cities in Connecticut with populations in excess of 40,000 is determined by a formula provided in Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-3a(h)(i)(4). DESPP calculated the total requirement to be \$6,088,621 for FY 2023.

5. Multi-Town PSAPs

The Multi-Town PSAP budget item provides a subsidy for a PSAP responsible for the receipt and processing of E-911 calls for two municipalities. Funding is based on a formula in Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-4a. The budget requirement is calculated to be \$1,675,418 for ten multi-town PSAPs, which for FY 2023, includes a new consolidated PSAP comprised of the towns of Fairfield and Westport.

6. Coordinated Medical Emergency Direction Subsidy

¹ Conn. Agencies Regs. §§ 28-24-1 to 28-24-12a were amended effective July 1, 2020. The amended regulations enhanced the PSAP subsidy program so that it reflects more accurately call volume and population served, while protecting existing large regional PSAPs from significant declines in funding. The amended regulations also included increases to PSAP Training Funds, Capital Expense Grants, Transition Grants, and Connecticut State Police Funding.

Municipalities in the state will receive a subsidy for Coordinated Emergency Medical Direction (CMED) services as required by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 28-24-6a(a) at the rate of \$0.30 per capita. Based upon a statewide population of 3,603,448, the total amount for the CMED subsidy for FY 2023 is \$1,081,034.

7. **PSAP Training Subsidy**

The PSAP training subsidy budget item provides an allowance that can be used by all PSAPs exclusively for the purpose of providing E-911 related training for telecommunicators. Funding will be based on a formula of \$0.15 per capita, based on population numbers from the Department of Public Health (DPH). The total amount required for FY 2023 is \$542,353.

8. Telecommunicator Certification Training

The telecommunicator certification training budget item includes the cost of training public safety telecommunicators as required by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 28-30. It also includes the reimbursement to municipalities for Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) training. The total projected cost for the above training is \$192,582, which is comprised of \$92,582 in projected costs for public safety telecommunicator and EMD training and \$100,000 for contractual services for enhanced telecommunicator training.

9. Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications

The operational cost for the Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications for the FY 2023 is projected to be \$4,534,327.

10. Connecticut State Police Subsidy

This budget item provides funding for the Connecticut State Police (CSP) for the purpose of providing 9-1-1 emergency telecommunications services and is calculated with the formula of \$2.00 for each 9-1-1 call received by Connecticut State Police public safety answering points. Based on 9-1-1 call counts from 2021, the subsidy for CSP will be \$803,630 for FY 2023.

11. EMS Data Subsidy to Department of Public Health

The Emergency Medical Service (EMS) annual data subsidy is intended to facilitate the collection of EMS data within DPH, as required by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 28-24(c)(7). The FY 2023 budget requirement is \$250,000.

12. New Multi-Town PSAP

A hypothetical group of municipalities currently operating as stand-alone PSAPs is used as the basis for estimating the cost of a new regional or multi-town emergency communications center. The DESPP anticipated additional regionalization efforts and the estimated cost is \$276,644 for the FY 2023.

13. Transition Grants

Based on current known activity and requests, the DESPP estimated that two stand-alone PSAPs will form a new multi-town PSAP. Total transition grant funding is estimated at \$600,000.

14. Capital Expense Grants

Funding for capital expense grants is based on a formula of 20% of the total subsidy for regional emergency telecommunications centers and funded cities. Any regional emergency telecommunications center or funded city requesting this subsidy must provide matching local funds. The total amount required for capital expenses for FY 2023 is estimated at \$1,344,582.

The Authority has reviewed DESPP's FY 2023 Operating Budget and finds that it is consistent with the provisions of Conn. Gen. Stat. § 28-24(a) and Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-3a.

B. FEE CALCULATION

Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a prescribes a progressive wireline service schedule that is used by the Authority when calculating the E-911 monthly assessment fees for customer accounts with multiple lines.² The regulation provides that if the number of access lines:

- 1. equals one, then the assessment factor shall be 1.0;
- 2. equals two, then the assessment factor shall be .75;
- 3. equals three, then the assessment factor shall be .67;
- 4. equals four or five, then the assessment factor shall be .60;
- 5. equals six, seven, eight, nine or ten, then the assessment factor shall be .50;
- 6. equal to or greater than eleven but less than 26, then the assessment factor shall be .40;
- 7. equal to or greater than 26 but less than 51, then the assessment factor shall be .33;
- 8. equal to or greater than 51 but less than 100, then the assessment factor shall be .25; and
- 9. equal to or greater than 100, then the assessment factor shall be .20.

Based on DESPP's Operating Budget, the estimated number of subscriber lines, and the assessment schedule in Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a, all incumbent LECs,

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-256g, the E-911 surcharge progressive rate schedule does not apply to wireless services.

CLECs, CMRS, COCOT, VoIP, and wireless subscribers shall be assessed a per-line monthly fee in the following amounts:

The majority of companies responded to the Authority's interrogatories dated December 23, 2021, which requested subscriber line counts in this docket; however, several companies did not. The companies that did not provide responses will be subject to the provisions of Conn. Gen. Stat. §§ 16-41 and 16-247g(g). Each one of those companies is subject to a notice of civil penalty and/or subject to a notice of suspension or revocation of their respective Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity. In addition, those companies that did not respond to the Authority's interrogatories will be assessed at the single access line fee.

The Authority finds that the per-line monthly subscriber fees for wireline, VoIP and wireless subscribers are consistent with Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a and Conn. Gen Stat § 16-256g. None of the fees approved in this Decision exceed the maximum allowed per line/telephone number fee of \$0.75 in Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-256g(a).

IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDERS

A. CONCLUSION

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-256g and Conn. Agencies Regs. § 28-24-8a, the Authority prescribes an E-911 funding assessment schedule to generate sufficient revenues to fund the FY 2023 Operating Budget submitted by DESPP. All incumbent LECs, CLECs, CMRS, COCOT and VoIP providers shall assess a fee to their respective subscribers in accordance with the requirements in Section II.B. of this Decision. Providers that did not respond to the Authority's interrogatories will be assessed the single line monthly subscriber fee of \$0.70.

B. ORDERS

For the following Orders, the Company shall file an electronic version of the required submission through the Authority's website at www.ct.gov/pura. Submissions filed in compliance with the Authority's Orders must be identified by all three of the following: Docket Number, Title and Order Number. Compliance with orders shall commence and continue as indicated in each specific Order or until the Company requests and the Authority approves that the Company's compliance is no longer required after a certain date.

- Commencing July 1, 2022 until June 30, 2023, each incumbent LEC, CLEC, CMRS, COCOT and VoIP provider shall assess each subscriber a monthly fee as prescribed herein.
- 2. No later than October 25, 2022, and quarterly thereafter, (January 25, 2023; April 25, 2023; and July 25, 2023), all telephone or telecommunications companies providing local telephone service and CMRS, COCOT and VoIP providers shall report to the Authority, submitted as a compliance filing, in accordance with the table below, and pursuant to a protective order, the E-911 fees collected from such providers' end-users for the previous three months as reflected on the E-911 Fee Remittance Form.

In addition, each provider is required to submit to the Authority a copy of the monthly remittance forms filed with DESPP. Non-DESPP forms, incomplete forms or forms not filed by the quarterly due dates will not be considered timely filed. Forms can be found on the DESPP website at www.ct.gov/despp. The Authority will not accept a payment report unless it is in the prescribed format as described in the DESPP's website. Any reports not in compliance with this format for this Docket and any future dockets will need to be refiled.
