**Call to Order**

**Approval of the minutes**

Steve Schindler gave an update on the status of the PSDN refresh. Currently the project is approximately one year behind schedule.

**PSDN Technical Update**

Tim Searles reported:

- Open Access Requests Fulfilled
  - CEN ISP Service for King Street FD (Danbury)
  - CEN ISP Service for Ansonia PD
  - CEN ISP Service for Lost Acres FD (Granby)

### **Application Status Report**

John Masciadrelli reported that to date, the 228 PSDN requests that have been submitted to the PSDN Governance Board are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 207 of those requests have been raised, reviewed, and voted on by the board. All 207 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN and to date, there are 191 requests operating on the PSDN. There are ten additional requests awaiting an implementation date or in the process of being implemented, and the remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

### **Application Review and Approval**

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18708, Tolland County Mutual Aid is requesting access to the PSDN to provide a P25 audio interface/connection between East Windsor PD (primary PSAP for Law Enforcement) and TCMA (secondary PSAP for Fire & EMS) for emergency coordination. TCMA would like to utilize the PSDN for a dedicated connection for their radio consoles. This interface/connection will make both of TCMA's and East Windsor's operations more efficient and provide them with a redundant method of inter-agency communication. This is a Core Service and no vote is necessary.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18715, DESPP, State Police Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) unit is requesting access to the PSDN to support Magnet Axiom and Cellebrite software to case manage and examine digital forensic evidence on multiple devices and platforms. The unit will be moving to DESPP's Cheshire location and will need to access the shared data located at the Forensic Lab crime unit in Meriden on a closed network. Bob Guthrie made a motion to approve the request, Ralf Calciano seconded the motion. Request NM18715 was voted on and approved.

Mr. Masciadrelli announced that the next PSDN Governance Board is scheduled for February 19, 2025.
