Call to Order

Approval of the minutes

PSDN Refresh

Steve Schindler reported that 178 sites have been successfully deployed. There are an additional three remaining sites that are in the process of being deployed. Juniper and BEST continue to test Juniper and Anuta software on a daily basis. The BITS server team is conducting failover testing at the Springfield Data Center.

PSDN Technical Update

Application Status Report

Mr. Masciadrelli reported that to date, the 220 PSDN requests that have been submitted to the PSDN Governance Board are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 196 of those requests have been raised, reviewed, and voted on by the board. All 196 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN and to date, there are 186 requests operating on the PSDN. There are ten additional requests awaiting an implementation date or in the process of being implemented, and the remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

Application Review and Approval

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18614, Avon PD is requesting PSDN circuits to support a P25 compliant radio console at Avon PD. The circuit will allow Avon PD access to the Connecticut Land Mobile Radio Network P25 Zone 1 Cores. This is a Core Service request, and no vote is necessary.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18626, The Department of Transportation (DOT) is requesting a circuit on the PSDN to provide connectivity to the Connecticut Land Mobile Radio Network's core to support a P25 dispatch console at the DOT facility in Rocky Hill. This is a Core Service request, and no vote is necessary.
