### **Application Status Report**

John Masciadrelli reported that to-date there have been 194 PSDN requests submitted to the PSDN Governance Board that are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 172 of those requests have been raised, reviewed and/or voted on by the board. All 172 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. Mr. Masciadrelli reported that to-date there are 153 requests operating on the PSDN. There are 12 additional requests awaiting an implementation date or are in the process of being implemented. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.
