Approval of the minutes

Application Status Report

John Masciadrelli reported that to-date there have been 193 PSDN requests submitted to the PSDN Governance Board that are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 176 of those requests have been raised, reviewed and/or voted on by the board. All 176 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. Mr. Masciadrelli reported that to-date there are 162 requests operating on the PSDN. There are 12 additional requests awaiting an implementation date or are in the process of being implemented. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

Application Review and Approval

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18229 The Town of New Fairfield is requesting access to the PSDN to transport school security video from the local schools to the New Fairfield Police Department. The police department will monitor the videos for the purposes of public safety and security. DAS/BITS will provision a circuit between New Fairfield Middle School and the New Fairfield PD. Jeff Morrisette made a motion to approve NM18229. Bob Guthrie seconded the motion. Request NM18229 was voted on and approved.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18234 Trumbull Center Fire District is requesting the relocation of a CLMRN, Common Channel Gateway (CCGW) circuit from Southwestern Regional Communications Center (SWRCC) to the Trumbull Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP). The relocated CCGW will support Trumbull Fire District as a remote site. This is a Core Service request and no approval is necessary.
