Application Status Report

John Masciadrelli reported that to-date there have been 194 PSDN requests submitted to the PSDN Governance Board that are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 180 of those requests have been raised, reviewed and/or voted on by the board. All 180 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. Mr. Masciadrelli reported that to-date there are 170 requests operating on the PSDN.
