PSDN Technical Update

Timothy Searles, DAS/BEST, reported that DAS/BEST performed the following network services.

Application Status Report

John Masciadrelli reported that to-date 163 PSDN requests submitted to the PSDN Governance Board are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved to operating on the PSDN. One hundred and forty-five requests have been raised, reviewed and approved to operate on the PSDN. To date there are 127 requests operating on the PSDN. There is an additional request awaiting an implementation date or are in the process of being implemented. There are currently two on hold. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

Application Review and Approval

John Masciadrelli presented request NM17413 Connecticut Telecommunications Systems (CTS) is requesting a circuit on the PSDN to provide P-25 compliant public safety radio backhaul services between the Veterans Affairs, Rocky Hill and Electric Boat, Groton. This is a Core Service and no approval is necessary.

John Elsseser requested that the minutes reflect that the system has been vetted by a DESPP attorney.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM17495 Northwest Public Safety and Litchfield County Dispatch (LCD) request access to the PSDN to support server and data replication. Both NWPS and LCD will configure redundant Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Active Directory servers that will be available in the event their local version is inaccessible. The Active Directory servers will not be used for purposes other than accessing the CAD. Raffaella Coler made a motion to approve NM17495. Joanne Miles seconded the motion. NM17495 was voted on and approved.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM17508, East Haven PD to provide radio over IP (RoIP) connectivity for the town's P25 Radio Communications Network. This is a Core Service request and no vote is necessary.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM17517, the town of Berlin FD is requesting use of the PSDN to support P25 simulcast two-way radio communications for public safety users. The town of Berlin's microwave links between sites will be the primary path for radio data backhaul services and the PSDN will provide a secondary path to ensure high availability. This is a Core Service request and no vote is necessary.

Discussion

John Elsesser announced that the Coventry Public Works Dept. is now on the state radio system.

John Masciadrelli introduced Jeff Lett, the new Director of Infrastructure for DAS/BEST.
