Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2017 Regular Session on May 31:

- SB 1032 AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CONNECTICUT
PA 17-17 SENTENCING COMMISSION CONCERNING A TECHNICAL
REORGANIZATION OF STATUTES INVOLVING THE ILLEGAL SALE OF
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 982 AN ACT CONFIRMING AND ADOPTING VOLUMES 1 TO 13, INCLUSIVE, OF
PA 17-16 THE GENERAL STATUTES, REVISED TO 2017.
This bill takes effect from passage.
- SB 946 AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS'
PA 17-15 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL AND OTHER CHANGES TO THE
INSURANCE AND RELATED STATUTES.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 910 AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT
PA 17-14 OF EDUCATION.

- SB 908 AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS'
PA 17-13 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO THE STATUTES
RELATING TO EDUCATION AND EARLY CHILDHOOD.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2017.
- SB 888 AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE CAUSED BY A DOG
PA 17-12 ASSIGNED TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2017.

- SB 846 AN ACT CONCERNING SECURITY OFFICER LICENSES.
PA 17-11 This bill takes effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 842 AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S
PA 17-10 RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS TAKEN
AGAINST A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 839 AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES'
PA 17-9 RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING REVISIONS TO ITS STATUTES AND
REFERENCES TO INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY.
This bill has various effective dates. Read the text [here](#).
- HB 6520 AN ACT RAISING THE ASSET LIMITATION FOR COMMUNITY BANKS AND
PA 17-8 COMMUNITY CREDIT UNIONS.
This bill takes effect from passage.

As of this date, the Governor has signed seventeen (17) bills of the 2017 Legislative Session.
