<b>Recovery Coach Program</b>	<p>CCAR and DOC presented information on the Recovery Coach Program at DOC. As inmates from the addiction treatment unit are getting discharged, there is a referral and warm hand-off to recovery coaches. Parole is also able to refer. Recovery coaches connect their clients to local resources. Their role is to motivate, advocate, provide resources, be a role model/mentor, and a "lifestyle consultant."</p> <p>There are currently 6 coaches who have served almost 200 clients since the start. There are currently 100 clients engaged with their recovery coach. Two recovery coaches shared some of their experiences working with this population.</p>	
<b>ESI Update</b>	As courts continue to re-open, additional cases are being screened. A summary report was completed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jack Doyle will forward report for sub-committee distribution.</li></ul>
<b>Narcan at DOC Update</b>	Narcan kits and trainings have been provided to staff, inmates, and facilities. The challenge continues to be the distribution of Narcan to family members especially around unplanned discharges and unavailability of family members to obtain from DOC. Narcan cannot be mailed out to family members even after training. So far there have been about 40 Narcan kits distributed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Consider asking the public health committee or DCP for clarity on ability to mail Narcan kits.</li></ul>

<b>MAT at DOC Update</b>	Expansion of MAT at DOC continues but there are some minor delays related to DEA paperwork that is being addressed.
