

Opioid Settlement Fund Update for ADPC October 21, 2025

Budget Update

As of the first week in October, the State has received a total of \$161,184,046, with funding recommendations having passed for \$111,691,813 leaving a balance in the fund of \$49,492,506.

Newly approved OSAC project: Helping Youth and Parents Enter (HYPE) Recovery

- Expand access to opioid treatment for adolescents and transitional age youth up to age 21 in Connecticut through statewide expansion of Multidimensional Family Therapy (MDFT) for opioid use disorders, known locally as HYPE Recovery
- Expansion from six teams currently to a total of 14 teams resulting in statewide access
- Includes training MDFT Therapist Assistants to deliver posttreatment recovery supports using the evidence-based Recovery Monitoring and Support (RMS) model
- Total funding amount (2 years): \$873,352.18



Program Spotlight SafeSpot Overdose Hotline

- SafeSpot expansion to CT is now active!
- SafeSpot is a 24 hour-7-day a week service
- Operators offer real-time phone-monitored supervision of drug use
- Emergency Response activated if the individual becomes unresponsive

Program Spotlight HERO: Housing Empowering Recovery from Opioids

- Program includes Housing Voucher, Case Management/Recovery Support Services, and Client Support Funds for 500 individuals with OUD and homeless or at risk of homelessness in CT
- Pre-screener coming soon to the DMHAS website!
 - Complete pre-screener online
 - DMHAS reviews pre-screener and refers to HERO Service Provider Agency
 - Agency verifies eligibility, help apply for RAP voucher, provide case management and recovery support services
- Applicants must provide proof of housing instability, OUD, and Valid Social Security Number



Municipal Reporting—FY 25

- Municipalities report on Opioid Settlement amounts received, expenditures, and process overview
- Reporting portal opened on September 2, 2025
- Submissions were due October 1, 2025
 - -163 municipalities have reported thus far


