



## **ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY COUNCIL 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION UPDATE**

### **GOVERNORS BILLS IMPACTING SUBSTANCE USE**

[SB-888](#) REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO JOINT RULE 9. 'AN ACT RESPONSIBLY AND EQUITABLY REGULATING ADULT-USE CANNABIS', to implement the Governor's budget recommendations. (related: HB-6377, HB-5313)

[HB -6439](#) REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO JOINT RULE 9. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2023, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR', to implement the Governor's budget recommendations.
