SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE TEAM

- Provide services using a person centered approach
- Attend AA/NA meetings with individuals
- Attend and connect individuals to services and support by collaborating with CCAR
- Case management and collaboration with outside providers
- Provide education and support to families to provide a better understanding of mental health needs/supports in the community
- Groups
- Connect individuals to outside supports



SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT

- Provide individuals education regarding substances that they are reportedly using (urine screens/self-report)
- Utilize a harm reduction model
- Identify individuals who are at high risk for overdose and provide MAT(Medication assistant treatment)
- Provide education on using fentanyl strips and Narcan kits which are then provided to clients and families
- Make necessary referrals when needed to the opioid response team



RECOVERY LANGUAGE

- Educate staff in using recovery language when working with them in the community/treatment planning
- OUR LANGUAGE SHOULD REFLECT 1. Being respectful 2. Nonjudgmental 3.
 Understandable and clear of clinical jargon 4. Consistent with our body language
 Conveying a sense of awareness and recovery journey
- Just ask the consumer what they think would assist them in supporting their goal in language that is supportive
