<u>Community Support Program (CSP) and Recovery Pathways (RP)</u> <u>Instructor-led Training Course Descriptions</u>

Title: The Nuts and Bolts of Teaching Skills: Putting the Pieces Together

This full day course is designed to be a "hands-on", interactive session which will allow participants the opportunity to learn AND practice how to teach skills. The workshop will offer both didactic and experiential learning regarding life skills training both individually and in a group setting.

Title: Writing a Plan that Honors the Person AND Satisfies the Community Support Program (CSP) Recovery Pathways (RP) Chart

Description: This one-day training will provide "nuts-and-bolts" practical guidance for how to maintain a strengths-based recovery orientation within a comprehensive Recovery Plan which simultaneously meets rigorous CSP/RP documentation standards. The training will include a review of key indicators of best-practice recovery planning from both a process and a documentation perspective. A mix of didactic and practice-based strategies will be used to enhance participants' understanding of core documentation elements within the CSP/RP Recovery Plan, (e.g., goals, objectives, strengths/assessed needs, and interventions.) Finally, participants will have an opportunity to work in small groups and write a sample CSP/RP Recovery Plan based on a variety of case material which will be shared with the audience. As a means of supplementing learning developed within the training, participants will also be provided with several "take home" practice-based tools which will support their ongoing efforts to implement best-practice recovery planning, e.g., a completed sample CSP/RP Recovery Plan and a sample chart-review tool assessing key documentation indicators.

Title: Functional Assessment in Community Support Programs

Description: This course presents a brief overview of Community Support Programs (CSP)/Recovery Pathways (RP) and a description of functional assessments both as a means to collaborate with clients to develop recovery plans and to support "medical necessity." The presenter will describe the dynamics of working with clients to complete functional assessments and how to use them to make objectives and interventions.

<u>Custom Self-directed Web-based Training Specifically Developed for DMHAS CSP/RP</u> <u>Initiative:</u>

Title: Assessment in Community Support Systems (CSP) and Recovery Pathways (RP) Description: This training will provide some basic information on the steps in the assessment process in DMHAS CSP and RP Programs.

Title: Community Support Programs (CSP): From Maintenance to Rehabilitation

Description: This training will explore changing from a case management system focused on helping people maintain stability in the community, to one based on psychosocial rehabilitation. It explores helping people to develop the skills they need to live a more satisfying life.

Title: Recovery Planning and Documentation in Community Support Programs (CSP) and Recovery Pathways (RP)

Description: This web-based training is designed to be taken as a follow-up to Community Support Programs: From Maintenance to Rehabilitation and Assessment in Community Support Programs (CSP) and Recovery Pathways (RP). It outlines the elements of recovery planning and documentation in CSP and RP.

Related Self-directed Web-based Training:

Title: Tools for Engaging Clients in Services

Description: This course provides strategies and tools for engaging clients into behavioral health services. These include helping clients access resources, empathic listening, arriving at agreement for the reason for services and focusing on client strengths.

Title: Working with People Diagnosed with Schizophrenia

Description: This course in intended for staff working in behavioral health and related fields as an introduction to working with people diagnosed with schizophrenia. It will discuss symptoms, prevalence, course and possible causes, and will explore ways to provide support and services to people with schizophrenia.
