Legislative Update #17 February 28, 2019

The following bill will have a public hearing in the committee indicated below. For your information we have also included the date of the hearing.

<u>HB-7200</u> AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF CIGARETTES, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER AGE TWENTY-ONE. (Public Health Comm. Public hearing: March 4th)

Below are miscellaneous bills that may be of interest to the behavioral health community:

<u>HB-6786</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE DRUG ASSETS FORFEITURE REVOLVING ACCOUNT FOR DRUG TREATMENT BEDS.

<u>HB-6791</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE DRUG ASSETS FORFEITURE REVOLVING ACCOUNT FOR DRUG TREATMENT BEDS.

<u>HB-6896</u> AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN ABLE-BODIED MEDICAID RECIPIENTS TO WORK OR VOLUNTEER THEIR SERVICES.

HB-6987 AN ACT EXPANDING THE MONEY FOLLOWS THE PERSON DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

HB-7032 AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR PEER SUPPORT SERVICES PROVIDED BY CERTIFIED PEER COUNSELORS.

<u>HB-7046</u> AN ACT ALLOWING MUNICIPALITIES TO IMPOSE A SERVICE CHARGE ON NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES PROVIDED.

HB-7049 AN ACT PROMOTING EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

<u>HB-7090</u> AN ACT CONCERNING INEQUITABLE METHADONE MAINTENANCE REIMBURSEMENT RATES UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.

<u>HB-7093</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO INCREASE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

SB-966 AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY OF PSYCHOLOGISTS.

SB-967 AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICATION.
