## Legislative Update # 4 February 5, 2019

As our state continues the battle on opioids, the following is a list of proposals related to the <u>Prevention and Treatment of Opioid Use Disorders.</u>

SB-306 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM WEEKLY BASE RATE OF NINETY DOLLARS FOR MEDICAID-FUNDED METHADONE MAINTENANCE.

<u>SB-441</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF DRUG TREATMENT SERVICES AT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

SB-446 AN ACT REQUIRING PHARMACIES TO DISPENSE OPIOID MEDICATION IN BLISTER PACKS.

<u>SB-621</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUPPORT OF INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER AND OTHER MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES.

SB-726 AN ACT INCREASING FUNDING FOR OPIOID ADDICTION TREATMENT FACILITIES.

SB-769 AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT OF OPIOID USE DISORDER.

<u>HB-5146</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS SERVING INDIVIDUALS WITH SUBSTANCE AND OPIOID USE DISORDERS.

<u>HB-5341</u> AN ACT CONCERNING INEQUITABLE METHADONE MAINTENANCE REIMBURSEMENT RATES UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.

<u>HB-5443</u> AN ACT REQUIRING A STRATEGIC PLAN TO EXPAND ACCESS TO SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT SERVICES AND DETOXIFICATION.

<u>HB-5518</u> AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR LONG-TERM SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER SERVICES.

<u>HB-5623</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN EQUITABLE RATE OF MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR METHADONE MAINTENANCE.

HB-5655 AN ACT EXPANDING ACCESS TO SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT FACILITIES.

<u>HB-5729</u> AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO TREATMENT FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER IN CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

HB-5896 AN ACT CONCERNING DETENTION BY A POLICE OFFICER OF A PERSON WHO SUFFERED A NARCOTICS OVERDOSE.
