Legislative Update # 6 February 8, 2019

Law enforcement and firearms continue to be a focus of numerous legislative proposals. Here are bills the DMHAS Legislative Unit is tracking related to **Firearms & Law Enforcement Safety Services:**

<u>SB-380</u> AN ACT CONCERNING MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS TRAINING AND SUICIDE PREVENTION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. (*PUBLIC HEARING SCHEDULED*, 2/11)

<u>SB-699</u> AN ACT CONCERNING WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR THE TREATMENT OF POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER FOR POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

<u>SB-772</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND PUBLIC PROTECTION TO VERIFY THAT PERSONS APPLYING FOR CERTAIN FIREARM PERMITS HAVE NOT BEEN CONFINED IN A HOSPITAL PURSUANT TO A PHYSICIAN'S EMERGENCY CERTIFICATE.

<u>HB-5154</u> AN ACT CONCERNING MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS TRAINING FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

HB-5419 AN ACT PROTECTING THE IDENTITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

<u>HB-5895</u> AN ACT ALLOWING A POLICE OFFICER TO TAKE CERTAIN PERSONS INTO CUSTODY FOR AN EMERGENCY EXAMINATION.

<u>HB-6319</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF A PROBATE COURT JUDGE TO ORDER THAT A CONSERVED PERSON SURRENDER FIREARMS.

<u>HB-6377</u> AN ACT CONCERNING MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS TRAINING FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

<u>HB-6378</u> AN ACT RESTORING A POLICE OFFICER'S WEAPON AFTER MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT.

<u>HB-7054</u> AN ACT CONCERNING COUNSELING OR DEBRIEFING FOR POLICE OFFICERS AFTER TRAUMATIC EVENTS.

SCHEDULED PUBLIC HEARINGS:

In addition to the public hearing noted above for SB-380, public hearings have also been scheduled for the following bills:

<u>HB-5442</u> AN ACT ADDING CHRONIC PAIN AS A DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION FOR THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA BY A QUALIFYING PATIENT. (*PUBLIC HEARING*, 2/11)

<u>HB-6095</u> AN ACT MODIFYING REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR DETOXIFICATION. (*PUBLIC HEARING*, 2/14)
