Legislative Update #8 February 15, 2019

Below are bills related to housing that may be of interest to the behavioral health community:

Housing Bills:

<u>SB-488</u> AN ACT CONCERNING NONELDERLY RESIDENTS OF SENIOR HOUSING.

<u>SB-489</u> AN ACT LIMITING THE PERCENTAGE OF NONRETIREES IN SENIOR HOUSING.

<u>SB-490</u> AN ACT LIMITING THE PERCENTAGE OF NONRETIREES RESIDING IN SENIOR HOUSING.

<u>SB-520</u> AN ACT REQUIRING PUBLIC HEARINGS ON GROUP HOME APPLICATIONS.

<u>SB-686</u> AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING ASSISTANCE.

<u>SB-786</u> AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A WOMEN'S HALFWAY HOUSE IN NEW HAVEN.

HB-5136 AN ACT PROTECTING RESIDENTS OF SOBER LIVING HOMES.

HB-5744 AN ACT LIMITING THE DISTANCE BETWEEN CERTAIN GROUP HOMES AND HOMES WITH CHILDREN.

HB-6132 AN ACT CONCERNING SOBER LIVING HOMES.

HB-6790 AN ACT CONCERNING GENERATORS IN STATE-FUNDED GROUP HOMES.
