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Legislative Update # 3

January 26, 2021

I am continuing to review and track proposals that are of interested to the behavioral health community. Over the course of this week I will send out several updates highlighting the proposals. Below are some Senate proposals of note with hyperlinks to aid in ease of review:

Proposed <u>SB-183</u> AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC MEETINGS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.

Proposed <u>SB-187</u> AN ACT PROHIBITING SOLICITATIONS FROM OUT-OF-STATE RETAILERS OF MARIJUANA PRODUCTS NOT LEGALLY FOR SALE IN CONNECTICUT.

Proposed <u>SB-197</u> AN ACT INCREASING MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR HOME CARE SERVICES.

Proposed <u>SB-198</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE A TAX CREDIT FOR HOSPITALS THAT OFFER IN-PATIENT TREATMENT FOR OPIOID ADDICTION.

Proposed <u>SB-205</u> AN ACT CONCERNING TELEHEALTH SERVICES AND HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR SUCH SERVICES.

Proposed <u>SB-217</u> AN ACT CONCERNING MENTAL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PARITY.

Proposed <u>SB-219</u> AN ACT EXPANDING THE STATE'S RED FLAG LAW.

Proposed <u>SB-220</u> AN ACT CONCERNING INCARCERATED PERSONS WITH MENTAL ILLNESS.

Proposed <u>SB-228</u> AN ACT REQUIRING NOTIFICATION OF A FAMILY MEMBER OF A PATIENT ADMITTED TO A HOSPITAL.

Proposed <u>SB-229</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO EXAMINE THE RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS IN THE STATE.

Proposed <u>SB-237</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF OUTPATIENT MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT TO MINORS.

Proposed <u>SB-239</u> AN ACT DEFINING SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER AS A DISEASE.

Proposed <u>SB-244</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE INTEGRATION OF SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING IN PROGRAMS OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR EDUCATORS IN CONNECTICUT.

Proposed <u>SB-245</u> AN ACT PROHIBITING SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICIES THAT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST STUDENTS BASED ON NATURAL HAIR AND HAIRSTYLES.

Proposed <u>SB-246</u> AN ACT INCREASING ACCESS TO FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS IN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL RESTROOMS.

Proposed <u>SB-254</u> AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF INFORMATION OF STUDENTS WHO WITHDRAW FROM SCHOOL WITHOUT GRADUATING.

Raised <u>SB-265</u> AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SYSTEMS.

Raised <u>SB-285</u> AN ACT ALLOWING MEDICAL ASSISTANTS TO ADMINISTER VACCINES.

Proposed <u>SB-295</u> AN ACT DESIGNATING ADVANCE DIRECTIVE AWARENESS MONTH.

Proposed <u>SB-306</u> AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP TO DELIVER COST-EFFECTIVE HUMAN SERVICES AND DETER FRAUD.

Proposed <u>SB-308</u> AN ACT REQUIRING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFICIARIES TO WORK OR VOLUNTEER.

Proposed <u>SB-311</u> AN ACT CONCERNING A WORK REQUIREMENT FOR YOUNG ADULT MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES.

Proposed <u>SB-320</u> AN ACT CONCERNING STATE AGENCY COMPLIANCE WITH PROBATE COURT ORDERS.

Raised <u>SB-326</u> AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FLAVORED CIGARETTES, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS.
