Legislative Update # 5

January 28, 2021

There is a lot of session-related activity going on as the hearing process kicks off. Early next week two committees will hear testimony on bills that may be of interest to the behavioral health community. Hearings will be conducted virtually with committee members meeting via Zoom. Hearings provide an opportunity to give three minutes of testimony and answer committee member questions.

The Public Health Committee will hold a virtual public hearing on **Monday, February 1, 2021**. The public hearing can be viewed via <u>YouTube Live</u> and it may also be televised on <u>CT-N.com</u>. Individuals who wish to testify via Zoom must register using the <u>On-line Testimony Registration Form</u> by January 31, 2021 at 2:00 P.M. Speaker order will be listed in a randomized order and posted on the <u>Public Health</u> <u>Committee website</u> on Sunday, January 31, 2021 at 5:00 P.M. under Public Hearing Testimony. S.B. No. 326 (RAISED) AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FLAVORED CIGARETTES, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ELECTRONIC NICOTINE DELIVERY SYSTEMS AND VAPOR PRODUCTS.
